Visitation Jenny Erpenbeck, 2011-07-07 By the side of a lake in Brandenburg a young architect builds the house of his dreams a summerhouse with wrought iron balconies stained glass windows the colour of jewels and a bedroom with a hidden closet all set within a beautiful garden But the land on which he builds has a dark history of violence that began with the drowning of a young woman in the grip of madness and that grows darker still over the course of the century the Jewish neighbours disappear one by one the Red Army requisitions the house burning the furniture and trampling the garden a young East German attempts to swim his way to freedom in the West a couple return from brutal exile in Siberia and leave the house to their granddaughter who is forced to relinquish her claim upon it and sell to new owners intent upon demolition Reaching far into the past and recovering what was lost and what was buried Jenny Erpenbeck tells a story both beautiful and brutal about the things that haunt a home

Fuchs, 2019-10-15 In *Precarious Times* Anne Fuchs explores how works of German literature film and photography reflect on the profound temporal anxieties precipitated by contemporary experiences of atomization displacement and fragmentation that bring about a loss of history and of time itself and that is peculiar to our current moment The digital age places premiums on just in time deliveries continual innovation instantaneous connectivity and around the clock availability While some celebrate this 24/7 culture others see it as profoundly destructive to the natural rhythm of day and night and to human happiness Have we entered an era of a perpetual present that depletes the future and erodes our grasp of the past Beginning its examination around 1900 when rapid modernization was accompanied by comparably intense reflection on changing temporal experience *Precarious Times* provides historical depth and perspective to current debates on the digital now Expanding the modern discourse on time and speed Fuchs deploys such concepts as attention slowness and lateness to emphasize the uneven quality of time around the world

Domestic Disputes Necia Chronister, 2021-02-08 *Domestic Disputes* is the first monograph in German studies to offer a critical examination of the home ownership crisis in the former East Germany that resulted from unification policy taking as its focus news media made for television movies cinematic releases and prose fiction that depict property disputes between former East and West Germans In the cultural productions discussed in this book anxieties about social disenfranchisement through unification policy are dramatized in narratives in which Westerners acquire or attempt to acquire property in the former East Germany Each chapter addresses a different type of narrative that has emerged to frame those anxieties including those of neocolonial Western takeover the engagement with difficult family histories masculinity crises in the West and the corporatization of home *Domestic Disputes* is the first book length study to outline the way in which homes were awarded to individuals and families as the former East Germany privatized and to offer in depth examinations of the narratives that emerged from that social phenomenon

Experiences of Migration Odile Heynders, 2025-07-03 In the context of heated political and societal debates about migrants refugees and asylum seekers this book asks what singular people on migratory trajectories are experiencing and what their motives and hopes for travelling are The answers to this question will be found in literary fiction the book's main thesis being that it is in fiction in the creative invention of characters in time and space that we can find in depth knowledge on migratory experiences Although in most migration studies literature is left out because it is considered the opposite of academic reasoning this project starts in literary fiction and relates the imaginary work to concepts and topics discussed in migration studies hospitality asylum procedures in a city courage female migrants hope re settlement home country return migration In the interconnection of literary fiction and interdisciplinary research sensate knowledge is built as the interconnection of senses and intellectual thinking

Atrocity Bruce Robbins, 2025-02-04 Exploring literary representations of mass violence Bruce Robbins traces the emergence of a cosmopolitan recognition of atrocity Mass violence did not always have a name Like conquest what we think of now as atrocities have not always invited indignation or been seen to violate moral norms Venturing from the Bible to Zadie Smith Robbins explores the literature of suffering to show how over time abhorrence of mass violence takes shape With it comes the emergence of a necessary element of cosmopolitanism the ability to look at one's own nation with the critical eyes of a stranger Drawing on a vast written archive and with penetrating insight Robbins takes up such literary representations of violence as Bartolom de las Casas's account of his fellow Spaniards' atrocities Kurt Vonnegut's *Slaughterhouse-Five* Grimmelshausen's 1668 novel *Simplicissimus* David Mitchell's *Cloud Atlas* Gabriel Garcia Marquez's *One Hundred Years of Solitude* Homero Aridjis's short novel *Smyrna* in

Flames and Tolstoy's Hadji Murat These essential texts do more than simply testify to atrocious acts In their literariness they take the risk of contextualizing and relativizing thereby extending beyond the legal paradigm of accusation They recognize atrocity as a moral scandal about which something should be done and can be done while they also place that scandal within a larger and more uncertain history

Root Fractures Diana Khoi Nguyen, 2024-01-30 National Book Award finalist Diana Khoi Nguyen's second poetry collection a haunting of a family's past upon its present and a frank reckoning with how loss and displacement transform mothers and daughters across generations In *Root Fractures* Diana Khoi Nguyen excavates the moments of rupture in a family a mother who was forced underground after the Fall of Saigon a father who engineered a new life in California as an immigrant a brother who cut himself out of every family picture before cutting himself out of their lives entirely And as new generations of the family come of age opportunities to begin anew blend with visitations from the past Through poems of disarming honesty and personal risk Nguyen examines what takes root after a disaster and how we can make a story out of the broken pieces of our lives

The End of Days Jenny Erpenbeck, 2014-11-06 Winner of the 2015 Independent Foreign Fiction Prize From one of the most daring voices in European fiction this is a story of the twentieth century traced through the various possible lives of one woman She is a baby who barely suffocates in the cradle Or perhaps not She lives to become as an adult and dies beloved Or dies betrayed Or perhaps not Her memory is honoured Or she is forgotten by everyone Moving from a small Galician town at the turn of the century through pre war Vienna and Stalin's Moscow to present day Berlin Jenny Erpenbeck homes in on the moments when life follows a particular branch and fate suddenly emerges from the sly interplay between history character and pure chance *The End of Days* is a novel that pulls apart the threads of destiny and allows us to see the present and the past anew

Literature and Mnemonic Migration Eneken Laanes, Jessica Ortner, Tea Sindbæk-Andersen, 2025-05-19 This book deals with mnemonic migration understood as the movement of memories across linguistic cultural and mnemonic borders via the medium of literature In contemporary literature there is a growing number of authors with migration experience some of whom write not in native tongue but in their second or third language and who represent their experience of migration as encounter of different historical memories When migrating to a new place people enter not only a new political and cultural structure but also a new framework of memory They need to adjust their historical imaginaries thereby also contesting and expanding the framework they enter The volume explores how contemporary literature addresses specific historical legacies juxtaposes them multidirectionally and disseminates them in original and through translation in different parts of the world and in various social contexts Furthermore this volume traces literature's role in the processes of memory circulation translation and reception from the interdisciplinary perspectives of cultural memory studies translation studies reception studies and the studies of migrant and multilingual literature

Rereading East Germany Karen Leeder, 2016-01-14 This volume is the first to address the culture of the German Democratic Republic GDR as a historical entity but also to trace the afterlife of East Germany in the decades
