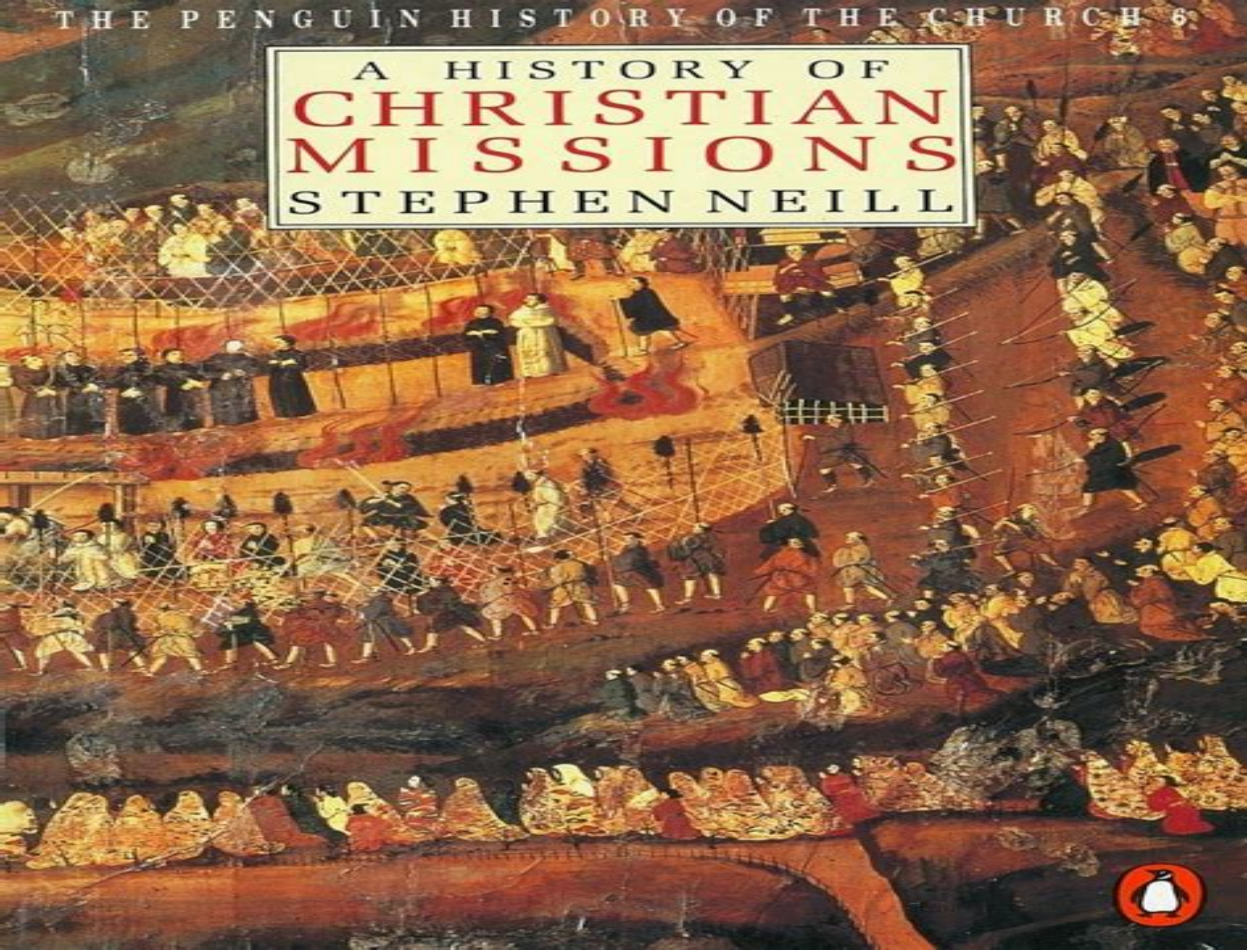

years This book clarifies the relation of the MBiC to the parent Mennonite Church and corrects some of the prevailing stories of early Pentecostalism in Canada It explores differences between collectivist denominational life in the denomination s first generations shared with other rural holiness Canadian churches and the congregationalist culture of twenty first century evangelical Canadian Christianity
