Hall Richard Dellamora, 2011-05-31 *The Well of Loneliness* is probably the most famous lesbian novel ever written and certainly the most widely read. It contains no explicit sex scenes yet in 1928 the year in which the novel was published it was deemed obscene in a British court of law for its defense of sexual inversion and was forbidden for sale or import into England. Its author Radclyffe Hall was already well known as a writer and West End celebrity but the fame and notoriety of that one book has all but eclipsed a literary output of some half dozen other novels and several volumes of poetry. In *Radclyffe Hall: A Life in the Writing* Richard Dellamora offers the first full look at the entire range of Hall's published and unpublished works of fiction, poetry, and autobiography and reads through them to demonstrate how she continually played with the details of her own life to help fashion her own identity as well as to bring into existence a public lesbian culture. Along the way Dellamora revises many of the truisms about Hall that had their origins in the memoirs of her long-term partner Una Troubridge and that have found an afterlife in the writings of Hall's biographers. In detailing Hall's explorations of the self Dellamora is the first seriously to consider their contexts in Freudian psychoanalysis as understood in England in the 1920s. As important, he uncovers Hall's involvement with other modes of speculative psychology including Spiritualism, Theosophy, and an eclectic brand of Christian and Buddhist mysticism. Dellamora's Hall is a woman of complex accommodations able to reconcile her marriage to Troubridge with her passionate affairs with other women and her experimental approach to gender and sexuality with her conservative politics and Catholicism. She is above all a thinker continually inventive about the connections between selfhood and desire, a figure who has much to contribute to our own efforts to understand transgendered and transsexual existence today.

Thinking through the Mothers Janet Beizer, 2011-03-15 If questions of subjectivity and identification are at stake in all biographical writing, they are particularly trenchant for contemporary women biographers of women. Often their efforts to exhume buried lives in hope of finding spiritual foremothers awaken maternal phantoms that must be embraced or confronted. Do women writing in fact have any greater access to their own mothers' lives than to the lives of other women whose stories have been swept away like dust in the debris of the past? In *Thinking through the Mothers* Janet Beizer surveys modern women's biographies and contemplates alternatives to an approach based in lineage and the form of thought that emphasizes the line, the path, hierarchy, unity, resemblance, reflection, and the aesthetic mimesis that depends on these ideas. Through close readings of memoirs and fictions about mothers, Beizer explores how biographers of the women who came before rehearse and rewrite relationships to their own mothers biographically as they seek to appropriate the past in a hybrid genre she calls bioautography. *Thinking through the Mothers* features the work of George Sand and Colette and spans such varied figures as Gustave Flaubert, Julian Barnes, Louise Colet, Eunice Lipton, Vladimir Nabokov, Hugues Bouchardeau, and Christa Wolf. Beizer seeks an alternative to women's salvation biography or resurrection biography that might resist nostalgia, be attentive to silence, and reinvent the means to represent the lives of precursors without appropriating traditional models of genealogy.

Someone Michael Lucey, 2019-04-05 Imagine trying to

tell someone something about yourself and your desires for which there are no words What if the mere attempt at expression was bound to misfire to efface the truth of that ineluctable something In Someone Michael Lucey considers characters from twentieth century French literary texts whose sexual forms prove difficult to conceptualize or represent The characters expressing these misfit sexualities gravitate towards same sex encounters Yet they differ in subtle but crucial ways from mainstream gay or lesbian identities whether because of a discordance between gender identity and sexuality practices specific to a certain place and time or the fleetingness or non exclusivity of desire Investigating works by Simone de Beauvoir Colette Jean Genet and others Lucey probes both the range of same sex sexual forms in twentieth century France and the innovative literary language authors have used to explore these evanescent forms As a portrait of fragile sexualities that involve awkward and delicate maneuvers and modes of articulation Someone reveals just how messy the ways in which we experience and perceive sexuality remain even to ourselves

For decades Elisabeth Ladenson says critics have misread or ignored a crucial element in Marcel Proust's fiction his representation of lesbians Her challenging new book definitively establishes the centrality of lesbianism as sexual obsession and aesthetic model in Proust's vast novel *A la recherche du temps perdu* Traditional readings of the Recherche have dismissed Proust's Gomorrah his term for women who love other women as a veiled portrayal of the novelist's own homosexuality More recently queer positive rereadings have viewed the novel's treatment of female sexuality as ancillary to its accounts of Sodom and its meditations on time and memory Ladenson instead demonstrates the primacy of lesbianism to the novel showing that Proust's lesbians are the only characters to achieve a plenitude of reciprocated desire The example of Sodom by contrast is characterized by frustrated longing and self loathing She locates the work's paradigm of hermetic relations between women in the self sufficient bond between the narrator's mother and grandmother Ladenson traces Proust's depictions of male and female homosexuality from his early work onward and contextualizes his account of lesbianism in late nineteenth century sexology and early twentieth century thought A vital contribution to the fields of queer theory and of French literature and culture Ladenson's book marks a new stage in Proust studies and provides a fascinating chapter in the history of a literary masterpiece's reception

The Frail Social Body Carolyn J. Physics of Materials Yves Quere, 2020-11-18 Few areas of science are as interdisciplinary as materials science Chemistry physics mechanical engineering and mathematics each play a part within it The role of physics is to describe the objects effects and phenomena at different scales micro meso and macroscopic as precisely as possible Physics of Materials addresses this description at the elementary level Based on an undergraduate level course taught at the Ecole Polytechnique France the main emphasis is on the conduction related phenomena electronic properties and the plastic behavior ionic properties of materials such as metals and alloys semiconductors and ceramics It assumes a basic grounding in statistical physics quantum mechanics and elasticity but does not require prior knowledge of solid state physics to which it
