Oocyte cryopreservation

Oocyte cryopreservation (Freezing) is a procedure used to preserve women's eggs (**oocytes**). This technique has been used to enable women to postpone pregnancy to a later date, whether for medical or social reasons. Document 1 shows the steps of oocyte cryopreservation.

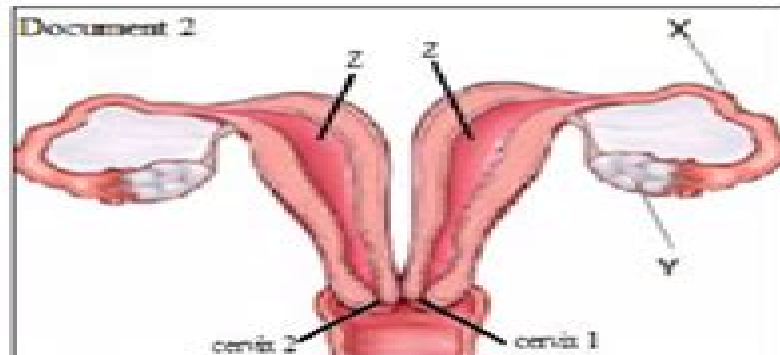
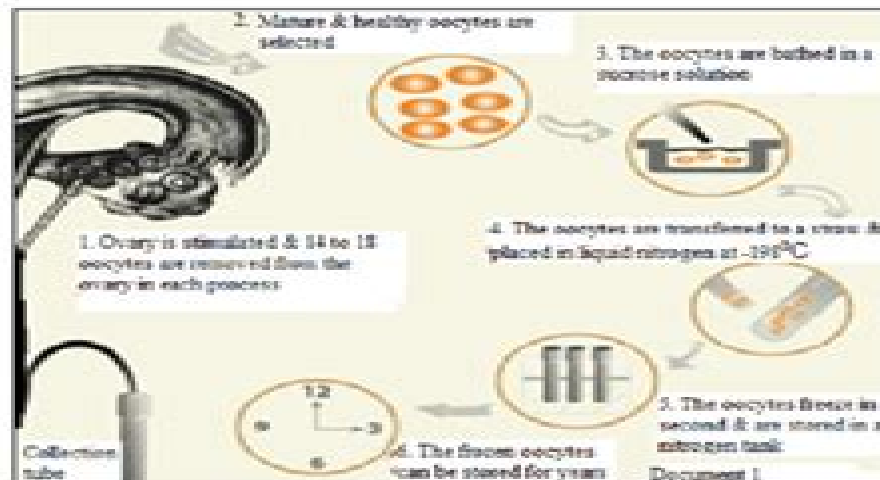
1. Describe, in a short text, the experiment presented in (Doc. 1).
