- 2. Consider how the child behaves with others, not just with you. Try to take the whole picture into account.
- 3. Try to consider whether a given behavior interferes with the child's development, functioning or relationships.

For example body rocking or social withdrawal might not disrupt other people, but it probably hinders individual development or functioning.
