The following CPT® codes are frequently used by occupational therapists to report services in various settings. Not all codes available to OT practitioners are listed. It is the responsibility of the practitioner to be aware of coding changes and to bill for services accordingly. Note that not all codes are accepted by all payers, and state regulations may have limitations on codes that can be utilized. Refer to the CPT® coding book for additional resources.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY EVALUATIONS

Occupational therapy evaluations include an occupational profile, medical and therapy history, relevant assessments, and development of a plan of care, which reflects the therapist's clinical reasoning and interpretation of the data.
