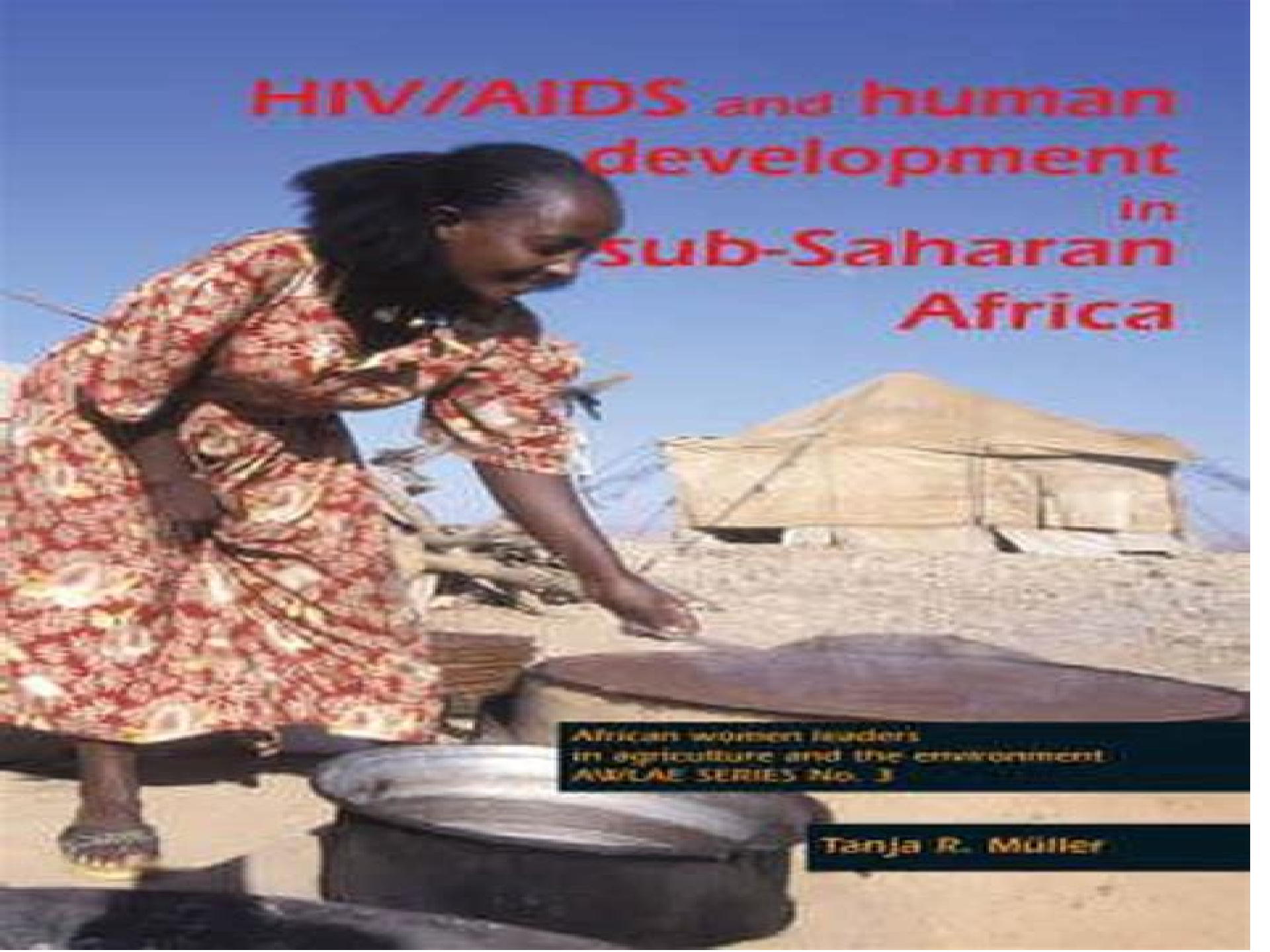

Human Development report the idea of human security has become increasingly influential among academics and international development practitioners. Women are disproportionately more vulnerable to disease and other forms of human insecurity due to differences in entitlement, empowerment and an array of other ecological and socio-economic factors.
