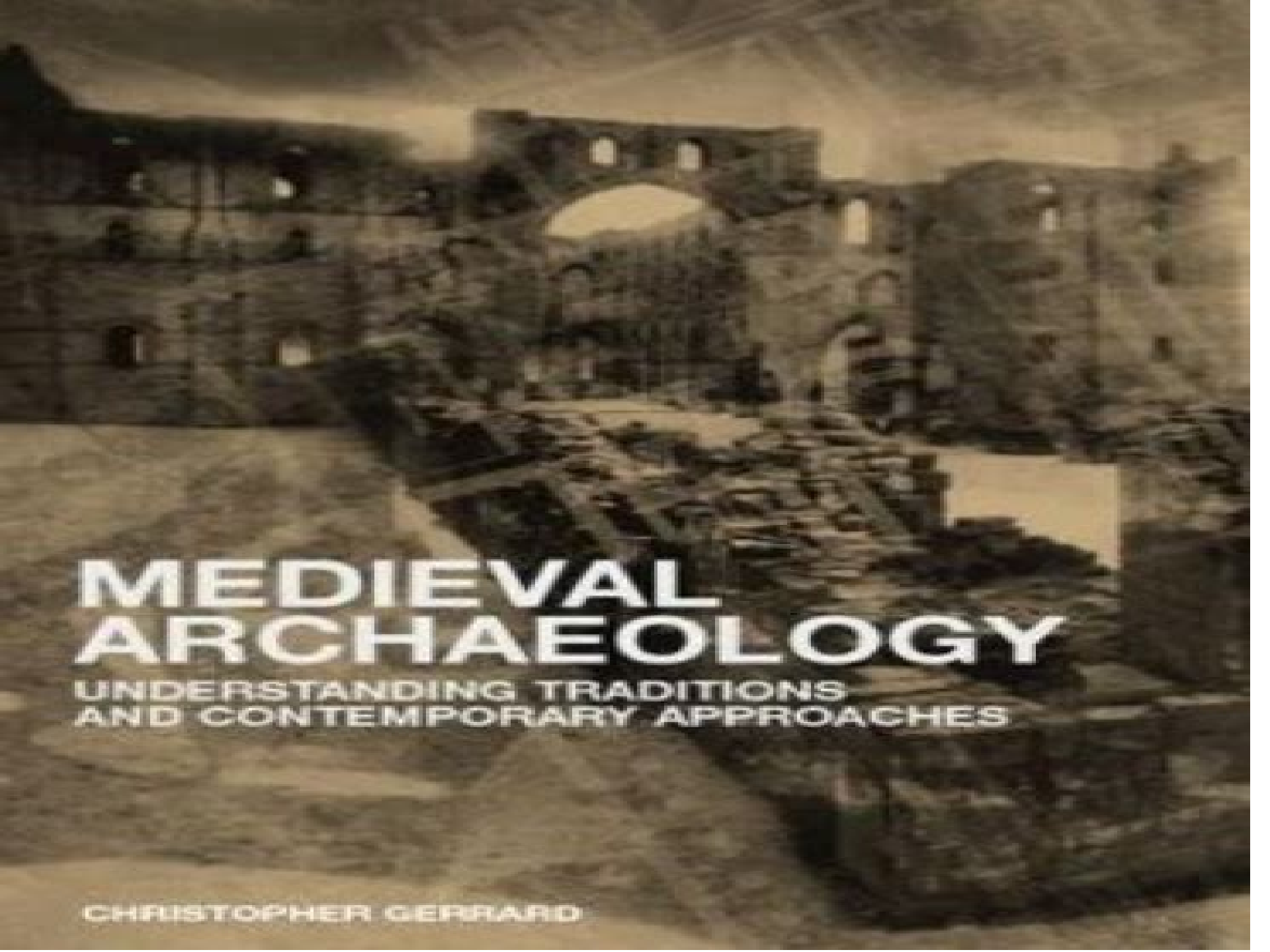

Archaeology, Theory and the Middle Ages John Moreland, 2010 In this important volume of collected essays John Moreland demonstrates the ways in which a theoretically informed archaeology significantly enhances our understanding of the early Middle Ages and indeed of the past more generally Beginning from the premise that theory must be worked through in data since abstract theorising conjures up only a historical pictures of the past he applies a consistent and contemporary body of theory broadly characterised as post processual in a series of case studies The essays are enhanced by extensive notes and commentary updating theoretical perspectives on and data pertaining to some of the key issues in contemporary archaeology the role of theory identities the appropriation destruction of the past gift exchange object biographies the influence of our present on the construction of the past the impact of texts on past societies etc The result will be of interest not just to scholars and students of the early Middle Ages but to archaeologists and historians more generally

Bishops, Community and Authority in Late Roman Society Rebecca Devlin, 2025-10-01 When the bishop Hydatius found himself held hostage in Gallaecia a Roman province in the northwestern Iberian Peninsula by a band of Sueves in the year 460 he deployed his experience as an ambassador for his congregation and used his captivity as a tool for negotiating peace As this example shows bishops held considerable economic political and social power in the early Middle Ages The expansion of ecclesiastical influence was not however a simple consequence of the legalization of Christianity or a power vacuum that followed the withdrawal of imperial authority The transformation of the episcopate resulted instead from dynamic processes to which all status groups contributed and that are best understood through

contextual and diachronic analysis This monograph focuses on the clerical community in Gallaecia and employs a case study and interdisciplinary approach incorporating written and material evidence to put bishops like Hydatius in their larger social and economic contexts to elucidate why the people living and working in their sees would imbue them with increasing authority and explain how their roles within their local communities expanded This book Analyses the accumulation of political power social capital and local influence by bishops approaching them as part of a larger social system understood as a whole that experienced transformative change across all of its layers Deploys all evidence written material etc without privileging one form over the other a priori to produce a deep reconstruction of the social and physical contexts micro historical landscapes in which bishops operated to explain their rise to prominence Turns the problem of Iberian early medieval written sources on its head i e the NW and clerical authors are overrepresented by engaging in a series of diachronic case studies to develop a rich understanding of episcopal influence in the NW as a point of departure for understanding broader developments in the late and post Roman periods

Death and Memory in Early Medieval Britain Howard Williams, 2006-08-31 How were the dead remembered in early medieval Britain Originally published in 2006 this innovative study demonstrates how perceptions of the past and the dead and hence social identities were constructed through mortuary practices and commemoration between c 400 1100 AD Drawing on archaeological evidence from across Britain including archaeological discoveries Howard Williams presents a fresh interpretation of the significance of portable artefacts the body structures monuments and landscapes in early medieval mortuary practices He argues that materials and spaces were used in ritual performances that served as technologies of remembrance practices that created shared social memories intended to link past present and future Through the deployment of material culture early medieval societies were therefore selectively remembering and forgetting their ancestors and their history Throwing light on an important aspect of medieval society this book is essential reading for archaeologists and historians with an interest in the early medieval period

Art Historiography and Iconologies Between West and East Wojciech Bałus, Magdalena Kunińska, 2024-03-15 This volume explores a basic question in the historiography of art the extent to which iconology was a homogenous research method in its own immutable right By contributing to the rejection of the universalizing narrative these case studies argue that there were many strands of iconology Methods that differed from the canonised approach of Panofsky were proposed by Godefridus Johannes Hoogewerff and Hans Sedlmayr Researchers affiliated with the Warburg Institute in London also chose to distance themselves from Panofsky s work Poland in turn was the breeding ground for yet another distinct variety of iconology In Communist Czechoslovakia there were attempts to develop a Marxist iconology This book written by recognized experts in the field examines these and other major strands of iconology telling the tale of iconology s reception in the countries formerly behind the Iron Curtain Attitudes there ranged from enthusiastic acceptance in Poland to critical reception in the Soviet Union to reinterpretation in Czechoslovakia and the German Democratic Republic and finally to

Skre, 2011-12-01 In this third volume deriving from the 2000-2003 excavations of the Viking town of Kaupang a range of artefacts is presented along with a discussion of the town's inhabitants their origins activities and trading connections The main categories of artefact are metal jewellery and ornaments gemstones vessel glass pottery finds of soapstone whetstones and textile production equipment The artefacts are described and dated and their areas of origin discussed The volume is lavishly illustrated An exceptional wealth and diversity of artefacts distinguishes sites such as Kaupang from all other types of site in the Viking World Above all they reflect the fact that a large population of some 400-600 people lived closely together in the town engaged in a comprehensive range of production and trade The stratigraphically distinct layers from the first half of the 9th century allow us to put precise dates to the finds and to the buildings and evidence of activities associated with them The finds and structural remains make it possible to identify the activities that took place within the six buildings excavated We can distinguish between some buildings that were only temporarily in use and others that were permanently occupied Several of the temporary buildings were used by a variety of craftsmen while those under permanent occupation were houses and only to a secondary degree workshops Throughout the life of the town from c AD 800-930 trade links with southern Scandinavia the Baltic and the Irish Sea would appear to have been strong In the earliest phases of the town there was considerable trade with the Frisian regions probably with Dorestad but this link faded markedly in the second half of the 9th century probably because of the abandonment of Dorestad Within what is now Norway Kaupang seems to have been supplied with goods from the interior of eastern Norway Goods from around the western coasts of Norway however are

practically invisible Finds of personal equipment show that the inhabitants of the town were of diverse origins Many of them were from southern and western Scandinavia but there were also Frisians there One house can be identified as that of a Frisian household engaged in trade There were also Slavs in Kaupang although it is not clear whether they were long term residents

Symbolic Reproduction in Early Medieval England Katharine Sykes,2024-07-12 In the early Middle Ages the conversion of the early English kingdoms acted as a catalyst for significant social and cultural change One of the most visible of these changes was the introduction of a new type of household the monastic household These reproduced through education and training rather than biological means their inhabitants practised celibacy as a lifelong state rather than as a stage in the life course Because monastic households depended on secular households to produce the next generation of recruits previous studies have tended to view them as more mutable than their secular counterparts which are implicitly regarded as natural and ahistorical Katharine Sykes charts some of the significant changes to the structure of households between the seventh to eleventh centuries as ideas of spiritual non biological reproduction first fostered in monastic households were adopted in royal households in the tenth and eleventh centuries and as ideas about kinship that were generated in secular households such as the relationship between genealogy and inheritance were picked up and applied by their monastic counterparts In place of binary divisions between secular and monastic biological and spiritual real and imagined Sykes demonstrates that different forms of kinship and reproduction in this period were intimately linked

Anglo-Saxon Graves and Grave Goods of the 6th and 7th Centuries AD Alex Bayliss,2017-07-05 The Early Anglo Saxon Period is characterized archaeologically by the regular deposition of artefacts in human graves in England The scope for dating these objects and graves has long been studied but it has typically proved easier to identify and enumerate the chronological problems of the material than to solve them Prior to the work of the project reported on here therefore there was no comprehensive chronological framework for Early Anglo Saxon Archaeology and the level of detail and precision in dates that could be suggested was low The evidence has now been studied afresh using a co ordinated suite of
