Age	Recommended screening	Comment
Less than 21	No screening	
Age 21-29	Pap smear alone every 3 years	
Age 30-65	Pap smear and HPV co-testing every 5 years or pap smear alone every 3 years.	Screening by HPV testing alone is not recommended
Age 65 and older	No screening after adequate negative prior screening results	Women with a history of High grade pap smear should continue age based screening for at least 20 years
Women who have had hysterectomy	No screening necessary	Applies to women without a cervix and without a history of High grade pap smear or cancer in the past 20 years
Women vaccinated against HPV	Same as vaccinated
