to pursue professional careers and to remain independent in their approach to making art The message of the New Art was to relate one's art production to life itself and to personal experiences From these directions emerged a proto feminist art of great originality identified with women's issues The legacy of these artists can be found in radical changes in art instruction since the 1950s the promotion of non hierarchical approaches to media and acceptance of conceptual art as a viable art form
