Samuel Shaw, 2024-01-31 Samuel Shaw's engaging new book on William Rothenstein takes a figure who has frequently made a fleeting appearance in texts on twentieth century British art and puts him centre stage Informed by rigorous research in archives and private collections in Europe and the United States Shaw's discussion of Rothenstein's work as an artist campaigner educator and organiser will be of interest to anyone seeking out more complex cultural histories of this period Shaw's narrative is an impressive balance of detailed discussion about an individual's career and a larger argument about the tensions between the nationalism and cosmopolitanism that shaped the early twentieth century art world Sarah Victoria Turner Director of the Paul Mellon Centre for Studies in British Art In this superbly well researched book Samuel Shaw argues convincingly that a commitment to British identity including the experience of British Jews is in no way at odds with a cosmopolitan openness to artistic activity across the whole of Europe Asia and beyond This will be the standard work on Rothenstein in his time for years to come and required reading for anyone interested in the international artworld of the period Elizabeth Prettejohn Professor of History of Art University of York The artist writer and teacher William Rothenstein 1872-1945 was a significant figure in the British art world of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries He was a conspicuously cosmopolitan character born to a German Jewish family in the north of England he attended art school in Paris wrote the first English monograph on the Spanish artist Goya and became a prominent collector and supporter of Indian art However Rothenstein's cosmopolitanism was a complex affair His relationship with his English European and Jewish identities was ever changing responding to wider shifts on the political and cultural stage This book traces those changes through the artist's writings and through his art analysing a range of paintings drawings and prints created from the 1890s into the 1930s This book the first in depth study of Rothenstein's art draws on extensive archival material to situate his practice within broader debates regarding transnational exchange and the development of modern art in Britain

New Art, New World Margaret Garlake, 1998 During the years following World War II Britain was plagued by privation xenophobia and humiliation from the loss of colonial territories and political power At the same time the country was in the midst of a dawning triumphalism seen first in the Festival of Britain then in the new Coventry Cathedral and finally in the international status accorded to British art by the early 1960s This book sets the visual arts in the social and

political context of these complex years Margaret Garlake establishes the intellectual historical and organizational frameworks within which art was made and received by critics and the public She discusses problems raised by abstract art links between art and politics culminating in the Unknown Political Prisoner competition and misapprehensions concerning art from the colonial territories She describes such new institutions as the Arts and British Councils the Institute of Contemporary Arts and commercial galleries all of which played crucial roles in sustaining artists and promoting their work She examines the perception of a national tradition grounded visually in landscape and place but heavily influenced by politics And she investigates the negotiations undertaken by artists and critics sensitive to the nuances of tradition to respond to the impact of an international American oriented art Finally Garlake focuses on the broad themes within which many artists worked including public art landscape the city and the human body as mother sex object survivor or worker

British Art and the East India Company Geoff Quilley, 2020 Examines the role of the East India Company in the production and development of British art demonstrating how art and related forms of culture were closely tied to commerce and the rise of the commercial state This book examines the role of the East India Company in the production and development of British art during the eighteenth and early nineteenth centuries when a new school of British art was in its formative stages with the foundation of exhibiting societies and the Royal Academy in 1768 It focuses on the Company's patronage promotion and uses of art both in Britain and in India and the Far East and how the Company and its trade with the East were represented visually through maritime imagery landscape genre painting and print making It also considers how for artists such as William Hodges and Arthur William Devis the East India Company and its provision of a wealthy market in British India provided opportunities for career advancement through alignment with Company commercial principles In this light the book's main concern is to address the conflicted and ambiguous nature of art produced in the service of a corporation that was the scandal of empire for most of its existence and how this has shaped and distorted our understanding of the history of British art in relation to the concomitant rise of Britain as a self consciously commercial and maritime nation whose prosperity relied upon global expansion increasing colonialism and the development of mercantile organisations

Transculturation in British Art, 1770-1930 Julie F. Codell, 2016 This book significantly advances the field of art and empire our knowledge of imperial artists and our sense of the visual as a key medium for understanding the meeting of cultures under asymmetrical relations of power Back cover

Cultural Identities and the Aesthetics of Britishness Dana Arnold, 2004-07-02 This book examines British imperial colonial and postcolonial national identities within their political and social contexts By considering the export adoption and creation of such cultural identities these essays show how nationhood and nationalism are self consciously defined tools designed to focus and inspire loyalty The contributors present these ideas with particular reference to English cultural identity and its interaction with the Empire They examine the national imperial and colonial aesthetic how architecture landscape painting sculpture and literature were used appropriated
