This stored program computer was described in terms of idealized neurons, highlighting the analogy between the digital computer and the human brain. Aspray describes von Neumann's development during the next decade and almost entirely alone of a theory of complicated information processing systems or automata and the introduction of themes such as learning, reliability of systems with unreliable components, self replication and the importance of memory and storage capacity in biological nervous systems. Many of these themes remain at the heart of current investigations in parallel or neurocomputing. Aspray allows the record to speak for itself. He unravels an intricate sequence of stories generated by von Neumann's work and brings into focus the interplay of personalities centered about von Neumann. He documents the complex interactions of science, the military and business and shows how progress in applied mathematics was intertwined with that in computers.
