

Transcendentalism Analysis Unit Plan

Analysis of Selected U.S. Texts—Followed by Themes, Nature and Life/Followed by Emerson.

Primary Explanation—Romantic Texts (follows any lesson the class). Analysis of Famous Art (again, choose any artwork). Leads to Quotes from Other Course Selections.

Learning Objectives: The goal of this lesson is to develop Close Reading, as well as Analysis, Synthesis, and Evaluation skills. Speaking and Listening skills will also be focused through discussion. Students will analyze author's purpose, theme(s), diction, mood, tone, imagery, allusion, simile, personification, parallel structure, analogy, extended metaphors, metaphors, irony, sarcasm, paradox, rhetorical questions, parallelism, symbolisms, and other means of figurative language as rhetorical techniques. More importantly, students will synthesize the ideas in several selections American texts with poetry and art. Finally, students will evaluate the ideas of Romantic writers in terms of relevance to their own lives and contemporary American culture.

1. Identifying Critical Information
2. Examining Similarities and Differences

Final editing/prior to today's lesson: The teacher tells students that the Romantic texts that they are about to read and analyze are some of the most famous in American literary history. The teacher implores upon students the power of these famous U.S. writings to influence the culture of ideas. The teacher provides background information on Emerson and Thoreau, and relates the ideas of these writers to American Romanticism and Transcendentalism. The teacher explains that the writings of the American Transcendentalists continue to influence us today, and the attraction of these literary movements can be seen in poetry and painting, as well as in our contemporary culture.

The teacher reminds students about the Analysis Handbook from earlier in the course. This handbook will be useful as they read and examine the selections. See below.
