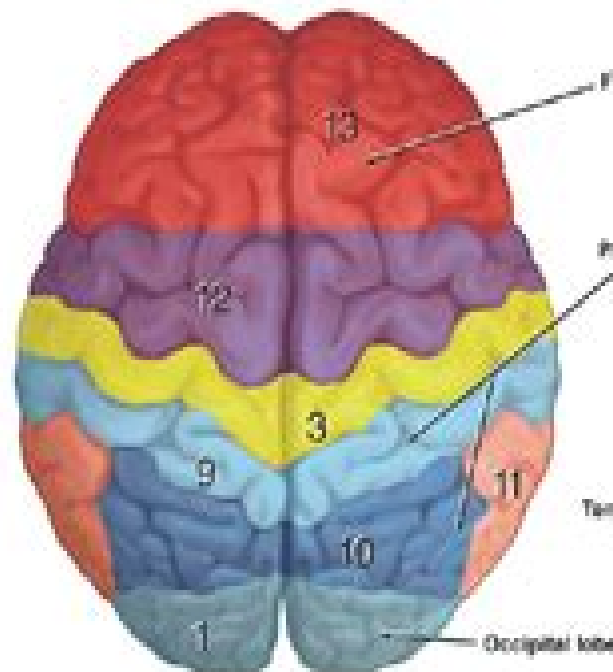

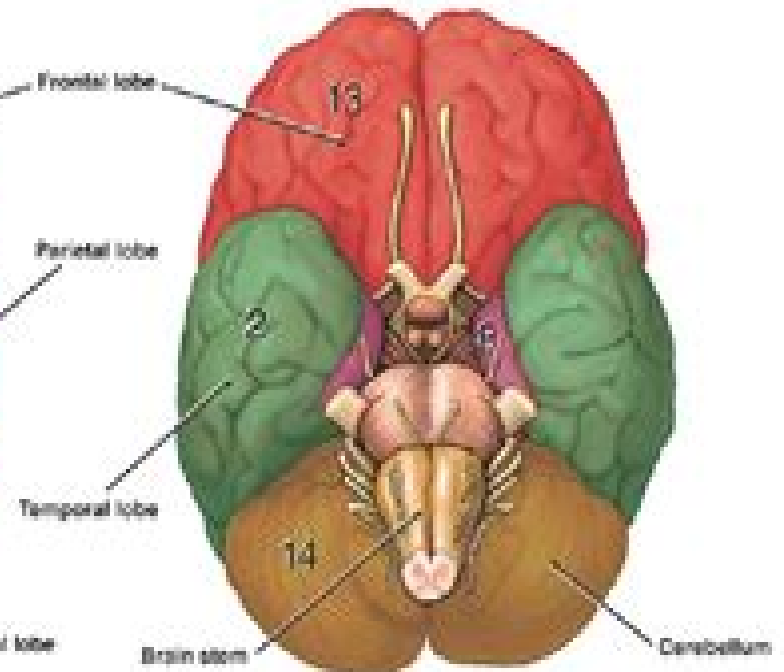
Lateral View
