Move up and off chest 2x.

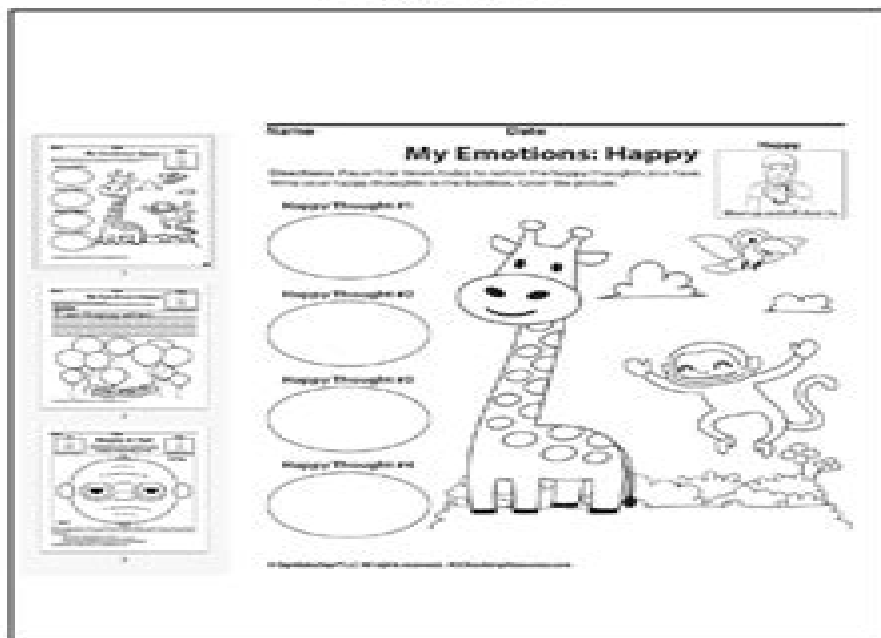
Students follow directions on each worksheet.
