primarily in Buffalo New York occasionally in West Virginia 1898 1901 and 1903 1908 where his father worked for Procter he joined Procter Gamble when the business failed

She is happy most when things go her way and has tantrums when things go sideways from what she wants. Gloria talks a lot about herself and does not talk much about anything else.
