Bernard Marx

Bernard Marx is a character who seems out of place in his society. Being an Alpha male, he has certain expectations to fulfil with both his actions and his physical characteristics, however, he fails to meet them. This makes us believe that he is the central character of this dystopian society – an outcast who will rebel against and expose the true nature of the Brave New World. However, as we soon realise, it is John the Savage who becomes this central character after Bernard's morals overtaken by selfishness. Huxley uses personification in "...what would it be like if I could, if I were free—not enslaved by my conditioning" to emphasise Bernard's open-minded thinking to the concept of freedom. The word 'enslaved' gives negative connotations to how conditioning affects the different people. This effectively questions the process of conditioning and leaves readers wondering if it is really a utopian concept of just a method of control.
