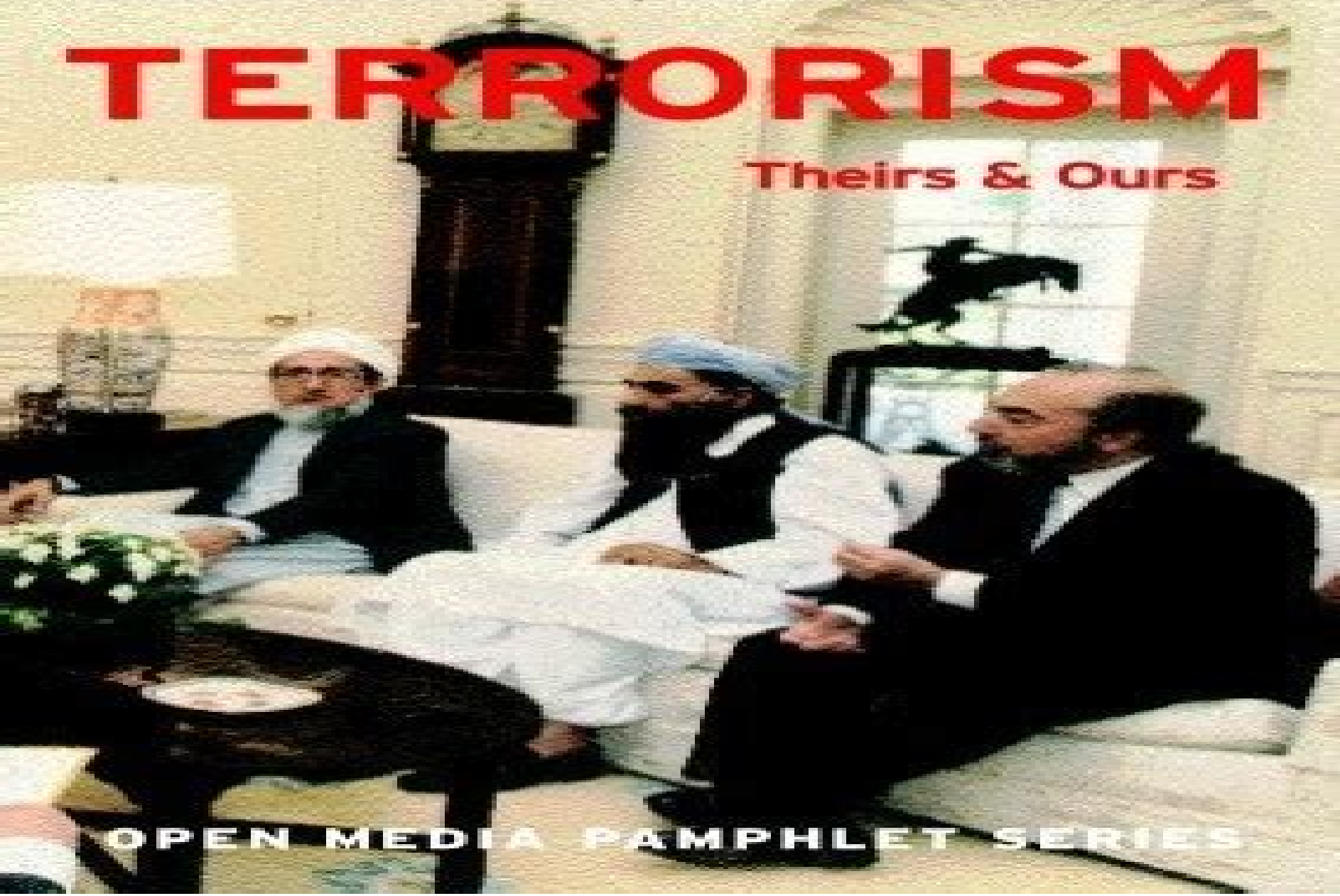

Terrorism Eqbal Ahmad, 2011-01-04 In 1985 President Ronald Reagan received a group of bearded turban wearing men who looked like they came from another century After receiving them in the White House Reagan spoke to the press referring to his foreign guests as freedom fighters These were the Afghan mujahideen In August 1998 another American president ordered missile strikes from the American navy based in the Indian Ocean to kill Osama bin Laden and his men in the camps in Afghanistan The terrorist of yesterday is the hero of today and the hero of yesterday becomes the terrorist of today In *Terrorism Theirs and Ours* Eqbal Ahmad holds up the concepts of terrorist and freedom fighter to U S foreign policy What do these terms mean Where do they apply How can the roots of political violence be stemmed An invaluable primer

The Selected Writings of Eqbal Ahmad Eqbal Ahmad, 2006 Activist journalist and theorist Eqbal Ahmad 1934 1999 was admired and consulted by revolutionaries and activists as well as policymakers and academics In articles and columns published in such journals as the *Nation* *New York Review of Books* *Monthly Review* and newspapers in Pakistan and Cairo Ahmad inspired new ways of thinking about global issues Whether writing on the rise of militant Islam the conflict in Kashmir U S involvement in Vietnam or the cynical logic of Cold War geopolitics Ahmad offered incisive passionate and often prophetic analyses of the major political events and movements of the second half of the twentieth century This work is the first to collect Ahmad's writings in a single volume It reflects his distinct understanding of world politics as well as his profound sense of empathy for those living in poverty and oppression He was a fierce opponent of imperialism and corruption and advocated democratic transformations in postcolonial and third world societies A uniquely perceptive critic of colonialism and U S foreign policy Ahmad was equally vigilant in his criticisms of third world dictatorships Like few other writers Ahmad's life experiences shaped his political views He grew up amidst the turmoil of postcolonial India worked alongside the Algerian FLN in their fight against the French occupation and later became a prominent spokesperson for peace between Israel and Palestine

This is primarily the main reason why the term has not been universally accepted by all scholars or academics. Any group that uses terrorist actions has very complex and powerful reasons to engage in those activities. The usual experience of violence by a stronger party has historically turned victims into terrorists. State terror very often breeds collective terror. Because terrorism is a word that has been used so much and so loosely that it has lost a clear meaning.
