Lenon,2004 Bob Lenon came from Nebraska to Yuma in 1914 just two years after Arizona had become the 48th state He remembers seeing the Colorado River when it had no highway bridges and traveling on a plank road across dunes where an Interstate Highway now runs Because Bob grew up listening to neighbors tales of gold in the hills it was natural for him to make mining his life as a prospector and as a mining engineer He became an intrinsic part of the process by which copper gold and other metals were extracted from Arizona rock In more than 90 years as an Arizonan he has witnessed many changes and in fact as a surveyor he mapped a lot of them In this second of two volumes Bob describes his university years and his work for big mining companies in Bisbee and then as a smalltime entrepreneur in a region where mining had fallen upon hard times He also recalls his service in World War II after which for 50 years he was a mining consultant and owner of a surveying firm in Patagonia In addition he recounts tales told by a few of the historic maps in his vast collection
