

He had opposed President Polk's Unconstitutional use of power during the Mexican War but Lincoln later assumed War Powers beyond Polk s or any other previous President He was known as Honest Abe and even political opponents remarked that his cards were always face up but he once intentionally misled Congress He agonized over the carnage inflicted on both sides of the War but continually ordered his Generals to push the fight to the Southern armies To Lincoln however these actions were not transgressions but strategies necessary to end the War and to achieve his overarching goal the preservation of the Union The issues of slavery secession and the Civil War are discussed to explore the effect of certain events on Lincoln and the life changing decisions he made
