Marx,2005-04-21 Common wisdom has long held that the ascent of the modern nation coincided with the flowering of Enlightenment democracy and the decline of religion ringing in an age of tolerant inclusive liberal states Not so demonstrates Anthony W Marx in this landmark work of revisionist political history and analysis In a startling departure from a historical consensus that has dominated views of nationalism for the past quarter century Marx argues that European nationalism emerged two centuries earlier in the early modern era as a form of mass political engagement based on religious conflict intolerance and exclusion Challenging the self congratulatory genealogy of civic Western nationalism Marx shows how state builders attempted to create a sense of national solidarity to support their burgeoning authority Key to this process was the transfer of power from local to central rulers the most suitable vehicle for effecting this transfer was religion and fanatical passions Religious intolerance specifically the exclusion of religious minorities from the nascent state provided the
