## Measuring Respiration

Key Idea: Bespiration is the process by which cells convert gergy in glucose to usable energy, which is stored in the solecule ATP. The process uses oxygen, which can be guartified using a simple respirometer.

a respiremeter can be used to measure the amount of angen consumed by an organism during cellular respiration and so can be used to measure respiration rate. A simple aspirometer is shown in the diagram below. The carbon

dioxide produced during respiration is absorbed by the potassium hydroxide. As the oxygen is used up, the coloured bubble in the glass tube moves. Measuring the movement of the bubble allows an estimation of the change in volume of gas and therefore the rate of cellular respiration. Various versions of these simple respirometers exist. You may use a set-up that uses micro respirometers, which are easy to construct and work quickly because of their small volumes.

Coution is required when handling potassium hydroxide as it is caustic and can cause chemical burns. You should wear protective eyewear and gloves.

- Work in groups of four to set up three respirometers using the set-up shown right as a guide.
- 2. Collect three boiling tubes and place two cotton balls in the bottom of each. Label the vials 1, 2,
- 3. Use a dropper to add 15% petassium hydroxide (KOH) solution on the cotton balls until they are soturated (there should be no Squid in the bailing tube). Add the same amount of KOH to the cotton balls in each well.
- 4) Place gause on top of the cotton balls in each vial. This prevents the KOH coming into contact with the seeds and killing them
- 5. Quarter fill vial I with glass beads made up to the same volume as in the other two viols. Determine the volumes using a water displacement method.
- Quarter fill year 2 with 25 perminated bean seeds. These seeds will be domp as they have been perminated under damp paper towels for four days.
- Quarter fill vial 3 with the same number of non-Germinating (dormant) seeds into vial 3 (making up the volume with glass beads).

- 10. Place all three respirometers in a 25°C water both supported so that the pipeste tips stay out of the water (see diagram right). Leave for 10 minutes to equilibrate
- 11. After 10 minutes of equilibration, record the position of the food colouring bubble and start a timer.
- 12. The recorded movement of the coloured bubble in tube 1 (glass beads) account for any pressure fluctuations, Subtract the changes recorded in tube 1 in each of tube 2 and 3 to obtain the corrected volume changes caused by the use of oxygen.
- 13. Record your results on the table at the top of the next page.
