6. In the novel, Brave New World, various passages and motifs are borrowed from works of William Shakespeare, including tragedies such as Hamlet, Macbeth, Romeo and Juliet, and Othello. To what extent does Huxley's novel meet the criteria of tragedy?

7. Discuss the transhumanist ethos that pervades the thinking of the characters of Brave New World. What impact does this mindset have on their lives? (If you are interested in this topic, see me for a primer on transhumanism.)

8. Who is the stronger leader: Mustapha Mond from Brave New World or Prospero from The Tempest?

Using examples from the novel, discuss the importance of the family as a social unit.
