Revolting Indolence Marcos Gonzalez, 2024-12-03 How indolent practices in Latinx LGBTQ culture challenge capitalist imperatives to be productive Revolting Indolence makes a case for laziness as an aesthetic political strategy for countering the oppressive logics of cisheteronormative racial capitalism Focusing on ways in which queer and trans Latinx people demonstrate the unwillingness of their participation in productivist ethics and allied respectability politics Marcos Gonzalez argues that slacking off lounging daydreaming and partying are liberatory practices revolts that in turn are treated as revolting Gonzalez explores how queer and trans Latinx artists refute discourses in which work is a moral good In Paris Is Burning RuPaul s Drag Race documentary photography of queer and trans Latinx life in Los Angeles and other sources Gonzalez identifies two lazy styles first flagrant refusals of work that critique capitalist reason and second the invention of alternative aesthetic worlds beyond racial capitalism and violence targeting queer and trans people whose rejection of the cisgender nuclear family paradigm is rightly seen as threatening the stability of a functioning capitalist system Reclaiming laziness as a resource for radical imagining Revolting Indolence asks us to do that which we want most and which capitalist exploitation can least tolerate to slow down

Matters of Inscription Christina A. León, 2024-08-13 A compelling exploration of materiality and semiotics in Latinx inscriptions Writers and artists from Cuba Puerto Rico and Latinx New York operate under the pressures of inscription the material and semiotic entanglement of making a mark as a marked artist By employing layered material tropes and figures such as stone dust viscera and animality their works do not represent a singular Latinx experience and instead must be read at the margin of language and matter Matters of Inscription explores feminist and queer inscriptions of Latinidad encompassing the intersections of materiality and semiotics in art performance poetry plays and fiction By delving into these figural matters Christina A Le n highlights how writers and artists such as Zilia S nchez Ana Mendieta Manuel Ramos Otero Mar a Irene Forn s Justin Torres and Roque Salas Rivera forge material inscriptions that transcend individual lives and call for a broader analytical perspective unmoored from biographical anchors The book urges readers to reevaluate the notion of difference which has momentarily sought solace in identitarian terminology Le n engages in rhetorical analysis that reassesses how the terms of Latinx studies have been challenged and how they are failing Rather than categorizing texts based on predetermined taxonomic terms or individual subjects lives the

book tracks figures situated at the edges of materiality and semiosis This approach addresses the continuous marginalization and dispossession that shape the phenomenon of Latinx identity *latinidad* by recentring conceptual questions of origin diaspora pedagogy and belonging The book contends that losses and deprivations should be rendered incommensurate to avoid collapsing the richness of different experiences or scales of ontological debasement By focusing on the interplay of materiality and semiotics *Matters of Inscription* challenges conventional approaches that seek to homogenize and anticipate what Latinx might mean and instead calls for a more capacious and nuanced analysis that goes beyond individual biographies
