war economy afloat during the post Cold War era by an overly expansive war on terrorism The prospect of accessing Iraq's oil incentivized the war in that country The need for ongoing wars to feed the voracious appetite of the military industrial complex through billions of dollars of arms sales has been an ever present factor in the wars in Afghanistan and Ukraine
