Epistemologies John Rieder, 2021-09-15 *Speculative Epistemologies* is about truth effects in sf which stands for both science fiction and speculative fiction It examines six narratives one from each decade from the 1960s to the 2010s that challenge dominant assumptions about the normal the possible and the real It asks what the patterns of overlap and interference generated by texts located in border territories that make their identification as sf problematic and sometimes controversial can reveal about the dynamics of sf s multiple subcultures e g professionals academics and fans the complexity of the genre s communities of practice and their routes of production distribution and reception and the genre s shifting position within a broadly conceived field of literary and cultural production The speculative epistemologies in these stories are counter hegemonic ways of knowing ways of imagining knowing differently and the focus of this study is their effect on the formation of identities and communities Combining the methods of genre theory reception theory and the sociology of cultural production the readings of these six narratives trace a history of sf s increasingly feminist racially and ethnically diverse philosophically ambitious and politically engaged character from the 1960s to the present Race and Utopian Desire in American Literature and Society Patricia Ventura, Edward K. Melzer's investigation makes it clear that feminist writings and readings of science fiction are part of a feminist critique of existing power relations and that the alien constructions—cyborgs, clones, androids, aliens, and hybrids that populate postmodern science fiction—are as potentially empowering as they are threatening.

Selves in Dialogue Begoña Simal, 2011 *Selves in Dialogue: A Transethnic Approach to American Life Writing* constitutes an explicit answer to the urgent call for a comparative study of American autobiography. This collection of essays ostensibly intends to cut across cultural, racial, and/or ethnic boundaries, introducing the concept of transethnicity and arguing for its increasing validity in the ever-changing field of American Studies. pay separate but equal attention to specific monoethnic or monocultural traditions as has been the usual strategy in book length publications of this sort but by critically engaging with two or more different traditions in every single essay Mixing rather than segregating The transethnic approach proposed in this collection does not imply erasing the very difference and diversity that makes American autobiographies all the more thrilling to read and study Group specific research of an intra ethnic nature should and will continue to thrive And yet the field of American Studies is now ready to indulge more freely and more knowledgeably in transethnic explorations of life writing in an attempt to delineate both the divergences and the similarities between the different autobiographies written in the US Because of its unusual perspective *Selves in Dialogue* can be of interest not only for specialists in life writing but also for those working in the larger fields of American Literature Ethnic Studies or American Studies

The Subject of Race in American Science

Fiction Sharon DeGraw,2006-12-19 While the connections between science fiction and race have largely been neglected by scholars racial identity is a key element of the subjectivity constructed in American SF In his Mars series Edgar Rice Burroughs primarily supported essentialist constructions of racial identity but also included a few elements of racial egalitarianism Writing in the 1930s George S Schuyler revised Burroughs normative SF triangle of white author white audience and white protagonist and promoted an individualistic highly variable concept of race instead While both Burroughs and Schuyler wrote SF focusing on racial identity the largely separate genres of science fiction and African American literature prevented the similarities between the two authors from being adequately acknowledged and explored Beginning in the 1960s Samuel R Delany more fully joined SF and African American literature Delany expands on Schuyler s racial constructionist approach to identity including gender and sexuality in addition to race Critically intertwining the genres of SF and African American literature allows a critique of the racism in the science fiction and a more accurate and positive portrayal of the scientific connections in the African American literature Connecting the popular fiction of Burroughs the controversial career of Schuyler and the postmodern texts of Delany illuminates a gradual change from a stable essentialist construction of racial identity at the turn of the century to the variable social construction of poststructuralist subjectivity today
