She is the most prolific children's author in history, but Enid Blyton is also the most controversial. A remarkable woman who wrote hundreds of books in a career spanning forty years, even her razor-sharp mind could never have predicted her enormous global audience. She lied about her childhood and never fully recovered from her parents' marriage collapsing. A complex and immature woman, Enid was plagued by insecurities and haunted by a dark past. She was prone to bursts of furious temper yet was a shrewd businesswoman years ahead of her time. She may not have been particularly likeable and her stories
