O'Leary,2014-11-01 This volume begins with Thomas Meyer s assessment of Anthroposophy s evolution since Rudolf Steiner s death and its future prospects He offers an overview of the eighty seven years of the development of the anthroposophic movement and the Anthroposophical Society the worldwide organization headquartered in Dornach Switzerland since the death of its founder The Society went through a very difficult and controversial period in the ten years following Steiner s death which culminated at its Annual Meeting in 1935 The result was the expulsion from the Society of two members appointed by Rudolf Steiner to its Executive Board Vorstand Ita Wegman and Elizabeth Vreede as well as the British and Dutch branches of the Society and many important anthroposophists who opposed the expulsions Meyer whose many books include Rudolf Steiner s Core Mission reveals the extraordinary concordance of four November 17 dates highly significant in the development of Anthroposophy On November 17 1901 the anniversary of the founding of the Theosophical Society in 1875 Marie von Sivers asked Rudolf Steiner to create an esoteric path suited to the Western mind which set Steiner on his mission On November 17 1923 Ita Wegman urged Steiner to establish a new Society with Steiner himself joining as both a member and its president Twelve years later on November 17 1935 the remaining three individuals of the Executive Board wrote to Adolf Hitler to plea for the Society s continued existence in Germany after being banned in Germany by the Nazi regime Profound connections underlie these events Four appendices supplement the present volume Appendix 1 presents a Chronology that denotes by year and day significant episodes in Steiner s life and in the development of Anthroposophy The remaining appendices feature for the first time in English in one volume significant documents pertinent to the Anthroposophical Society s Easter 1935 Annual Meeting Appendix 2 contains the Memorandum written by supporters of Marie Steiner setting forth a list of grievances in support of the expulsion motions adopted at the 1935 Annual Meeting Appendix 3 records Ludwig Polzer Hoditz s address in response to the 1935 Annual Meeting counseling against the expulsion measures Appendix 4 contains the letter in English and German

written by the Society's Executive Board to Adolf Hitler. This important book offers profound insights into the struggles for individual freedom and voice during the early years of the Anthroposophical Society. Seeing the dynamics of that struggle can help us today to overcome differences to work toward common purpose both in the context of our everyday lives and within a spiritually oriented community.

Inner Reading and Inner Hearing Rudolf Steiner, 2008-11 2 lecture courses Dornach Dec 26 and Basel Dec 27 1914 CW 156. These two lecture courses given just after the beginning of World War I stand as a kind of unexpected gift. A few months later, once the war became a reality, the possibilities for esoteric work would change and it would become more difficult to do spiritual research. But in the short interval before the true horror of the conflict unfolded, Rudolf Steiner almost by the way was able to give these lectures which lay out in the clearest fashion the path of anthroposophic meditation and its assumptions, language and consequences. The first lectures expand on the idea of inner reading and hearing as the path to spiritual knowing. The spiritual world gives something and we as spiritual researchers receive and then read or interpret it. Spiritual knowledge is not a matter of will, desire or intention on our part but a gift from the spiritual world for which we must prepare ourselves by silencing our desires, emptying ourselves and presenting ourselves in humility and devotion to the spiritual world. Then we become aware of the reality that the spiritual world is nowhere else but here all around us and if we dissolve the sense of being skin-bound, we can become open to it, reflect its images in our astral bodies and then learn to read them by identification. Steiner describes this complex, subtle existential and living process in which ultimately we can become one with the universe in a masterful way from which anyone who meditates or wishes to begin to meditate will gain a great deal. The second lecture cycle, *How to Achieve Existence in the World of Ideas*, deepens the themes developed in the first cycle so that the two together provide a useful guide to the processes underlying meditation or learning to know the spiritual world. At the same time, because work was just beginning on the building that would become the Goetheanum, Steiner connects the esoteric principles of its design with the overall theme of the suprasensory human being in relation to meditation and spiritual knowing. The volume closes with two wonderful lectures in celebration of Christmas. Here Steiner has a threefold emphasis: Christ supracarthy glorious and divine, fully united with humanity and the Earth and born in each human heart. To celebrate Christmas truly means that we recognize all three of these as one in the spiritual world, in the earthly world and in ourselves. The Destiny of the Michael Community Peter Selg, 2014-03-15. In two related studies, Peter Selg tracks the groundbreaking of the first Goetheanum on September 20, 1913, in the context of what is known as the Michael movement, the primary active impulse brought by Rudolf Steiner in 1924, which explicitly indicates the anthroposophic movement and its official society. The author shows the fundamental importance of this beginning in Dornach. He illuminates the fateful goal of the School for Spiritual Science through Rudolf Steiner's karma lectures, not only providentially in the sense that it involved individualities but also with regard to the future development of human civilization.

Michael's Mission Rudolf Steiner, 2016-03-21

This will generate a struggle covering the face of the whole earth. The one and only remedy for this nonsense being made of human evolution will be the path that can lead humanity to the spirit, the path of Michael, which finds its continuation in the path of Christ. Rudolf Steiner, Speaking in the aftermath of the Great War, Rudolf Steiner presents a series of extraordinary lectures on the power and mission of the Archangel Michael. He paints on a broad canvas in the context of cosmic and human evolution, revealing Michael's tasks in the past, present, and future. Originally, the countenance of Yahweh, Michael, has metamorphosed from a night spirit to a day spirit. As the Countenance of Christ, Michael helps us find a balance between luciferic and ahrimanic tendencies. The old dualism, such as good versus evil, says Steiner, needs to be replaced by the trinity of Lucifer, Christ, Ahriman. Filling our heart with the Christ Impulse creates an equilibrium between the luciferic influence that imbues our head and the ahrimanic influence at work in our limbs. Rudolf Steiner describes how humanity faces three dangers in the social sphere: spiritual life could flow into the pit of mendacity ruled by Ahriman; individual rights might descend into the pit of selfishness; Lucifer and economics into cultural sickness and death. Asuras! In order to prevent European/American culture from perishing, it will be necessary to turn towards contemporary threefold social ideas. Steiner also speaks about the principle of metamorphosis in connection with evolution and devolution, as evident in the design of the pillars in the newly built Goetheanum. Architectural styles are an expression of human evolution, as can be seen in Greek temples, gothic Cathedrals, the Grail temple, and the building at Dornach. Amidst many other themes, Rudolf Steiner addresses the problem of natural necessity and freedom, and the abolition of the trichotomy of body, soul, and spirit at the Council of Constantinople in AD 869.

Eternal and Transient Elements in Human Life Rudolf Steiner, 2016-03-21

In what has been referred to as the most advanced course in anthroposophy, Rudolf Steiner addresses one of the great questions of our time: the role of evil in human development. He speaks of the year 666, when three time streams intersected: the familiar linear stream and two lateral streams, and the reoccurrence of the 666-year rhythm in history. At the heart of this mystery is the being Sorat, the beast who attempted to flood humanity with premature spiritual knowledge by inspiring the scholars of the ancient Academy of Gondishapur. Although responsible for the saving of Aristotle's works, Steiner describes how the Academy generated tremendous but dangerous gnostic wisdom, which eventually spread through the Christian monasteries and inspired Western scientific thought. Its immediate negative impact, however, had to be counteracted by the Prophet Muhammad and the founding of Islam. In contrast to the 666-year rhythm in history, the 333-year rhythm is connected to the healing forces of the Mystery of Golgotha. The year 333 was a central point in the post-Atlantean age but also a pivotal moment in establishing the

Christ Impulse and the new equilibrium it brought to humanity allowing people to gain wisdom through their own efforts. Such wisdom enables insight into three key areas: supersensible knowledge of birth and death, understanding of an individual's life and the ability consciously to confront the adversarial beings of Lucifer and Ahriman. Steiner addresses a host of additional themes including occult Freemasonry in Anglo American countries, materialism in the Roman Catholic Church, prophetic and apocalyptic vision, dualism and fatalism in pre-Christian times and the delusion of time and space. Seeking to awaken his listeners to the urgency of the tasks ahead of them, he urges that spiritual understanding be enlivened with enthusiasm, fire and warmth of heart.

Youth and the Etheric Heart Rudolf Steiner, 2007-12. Who were the three wise men and what was the Star of the Magi that led them to Bethlehem? Using the dialogue form, Christian Hermetic Astrology explores these questions and the basis for the inauguration of Star Wisdom Set in the Temple of the Sun, where Hermes the Egyptian sage gathers with his three pupils, Tat, Asclepius and King Ammon. Educating Traumatized Children Bernd Ruf, 2012-10-01. Only through confronting and overcoming these powers are we able to find the path to our true humanity. The second essay deals with the figure of the Guardian of the Threshold as a Michaelic teacher and guide along the soul's path into the spiritual world. This figure Selg argues is far too little understood in our time. He is a spiritual being of great significance who offers help to all earnest seekers. This book represents an ongoing effort on the part of Peter Selg and the leaders of the General Anthroposophical Section at the Goetheanum to deepen and internalize the work with the Class Lessons for all members of the School for Spiritual Science. Freedom of Thought and Societal Forces Rudolf Steiner, 2008 6 lectures in Ulm Berlin and Stuttgart May 26 December 30 1919 CW 333 Freedom of Thought and Societal Forces offers a broad overview of Steiner's fresh thinking on what he called the threefold social order. He acknowledged that the demand for social change derives above all from the working class whom industrialization had forced into a kind of indentured life dominated by economics. From Steiner's perspective the underlying issue is not just economic however but also spiritual or cultural. Culture and the cultured classes have become estranged from real life. Society needed a free culture that includes all classes. It also needs to shift labor into the legal sphere of rights the only place where workers can find real freedom in society. Capital too needs to be liberated from egotism and allowed like goods to circulate freely. Above all Steiner understood that social realities cannot be separated from the spiritual realities of human existence. From this perspective we lack knowledge of ourselves as spiritual beings and thinking has become abstract. To remedy this we must first acknowledge it and then develop modesty and humility. Next we must increase our capacity to love one another and the world. Approaching this reality from another side we see that what ordinary individual thinking afflicts culture in general which becomes removed from reality. Culture like thinking must become alive and universally human. This is impossible however unless we develop what Steiner calls freedom of thought. Authentic freedom of thought is always ethical and overcomes egotism. Indeed a more general exercise of freedom in thought as Steiner conceives it provides a way through the twin dangers of materialism and abstraction that is through ahrimanic and luciferic worldviews which together threaten society in both the narrow sense through nationalism and globally through geopolitics.
