

Remote control flying weapons, he argues, take us well beyond even Georgo W. Bush's justification for the war on terror.

Drones, Chamapou contends, are the "noti-kamikans," removing all risk from war making and creating a hugo gulf between soldiers and their autagenists. What we are seeing, he says, is a flushamental transformation of the laws of war that have defined military conflict as between combatants. As more and more drones are launched into bettle, war now has the potential to become a realm of secretive, targeted assausinations—beyond the view and control not only of potential examine but also of citizens of the democracies regaged in it.

Far more than a simple technology, Chamayou shows, drinns are profoundly influencing what it means for a democracy to wage war. A Pheory of the Drone will be required reading for all who new about this resential quantion.
