Architecture in Communion Steven J. Schloeder, 1998 Amid the growing dissatisfaction with Catholic church architecture since the Second Vatican Council and the general lack of clear and vibrant direction in liturgy this book responds to the timely question of How ought we build our churches Drawing upon the texts of the Second Vatican Council recent papal encyclicals and the Catechism of the Catholic Church Schloeder examines this question in depth with regard to history theology iconography and symbolism Schloeder seeks not merely to analyze why modern churches are so uninspiring but he offers positive direction for the renewal of an authentic Catholic architecture one that respects the traditions of the Church s magnificent artistic heritage while advancing the vision of the Second Vatican Council The key to the solution is to regain a sacramental vision of the liturgy and of architecture a vision that will help us to build churches that nurture the human spirit with beauty and meaning

An Architecture of Immanence Mark A. Torgerson, 2007-01-22 Torgerson begins by discussing God s transcendence and immanence and showing how church architecture has traditionally interpreted these key concepts He then traces the theological roots of immanence s priority from liberal theology and liturgical innovation to modern architecture Next Torgerson illustrates this new architecture of immanence through particular practitioners focusing especially on the work of theologically savvy architect Edward Anders S vik Finally he addresses the future of church architecture as congregations are buffeted by the twin forces of liturgical change and postmodernism

Spiritus Loci Bert Daelemans, S.J., 2015-01-08 In *Spiritus Loci* Bert Daelemans who graduated as an architect and a theologian provides an interdisciplinary method for the theological assessment of church architecture Rather than a theory this method is based on case studies of contemporary buildings 1995 2015 which are often criticized for lacking theological depth In a threefold method the author brings to light the ways in which architecture can be theology or theotopy by focusing on topoi places rather than logoi words Churches reveal our relationship with God by engaging our body mind and community This method proves relevant not only for the way we perceive these buildings but also for the way we use them especially in our prophetic engagement for a better world

Sacred Space for the Missional Church William R. McAlpine, 2011-02-14 *Sacred Space for the Missional Church* examines the strong link between the theology and mission of the Church and the spaces in which and from which that theology and mission are lived out The author demonstrates that the built environment is not incidental or even subservient to mission Rather it is a key player in the fulfillment and the communication of that mission The book begins with a working definition of the missional church underscoring the connection between God s mission *missio Dei* and the Church s mission The reader is presented with

historical and theological frameworks for sacred space and reminded of the pivotal role of the built environment in the fulfillment of the mission of the Church. The design and construction of sacred spaces are shown to be fundamentally a theological exercise and not solely a matter of function, pragmatics and fiscal astuteness. The author questions the uncritical application of blanket statements such as 'form must follow function' and challenges the conviction that it does not matter where worship occurs, only that it occurs. The book addresses genuine concerns such as legitimizing the cost of church buildings and concludes with practical suggestions and essential questions that must be considered in posturing the built environment within the missional praxis of the Church.

Sacred Power, Sacred Space Jeanne Halgren Kilde, 2008-07-21. Jeanne Halgren Kilde's survey of church architecture is unlike any other. Her main concern is not the buildings themselves but rather the dynamic character of Christianity and how church buildings shape and influence the religion. Kilde argues that a primary function of church buildings is to represent and reify three different types of power: divine power or ideas about God, personal empowerment as manifested in the individual's perceived relationship to the divine, and social power meaning the relationships between groups such as clergy and laity. Each type intersects with notions of Christian creed, cult and code and is represented spatially and materially in church buildings. Kilde explores these categories chronologically from the early church to the twentieth century. She considers the form, organization and use of worship rooms, the location of churches and the interaction between churches and the wider culture. Church buildings have been integral to Christianity and Kilde's important study sheds new light on the way they impact all.
