families slaves were more than an agricultural workforce slavery was an entire domestic way of life that reflected and reinforced their status In many cases slaves were more constant companions to the white women of the household than were their husbands and sons who often traveled or were at war By looking closely at the complicated intimacy these women shared Schwartz is able to reveal how they negotiated their roles illuminating much about the lives of slaves themselves as well as class race and gender in early America By detailing the prevalence and prominence of slaves in the daily lives of women who helped shape the country Schwartz makes it clear that it is impossible to honestly tell the stories of these women while ignoring their slaves She asks us to consider anew the embedded power of slavery in the very earliest conception of American politics society and everyday domestic routines
