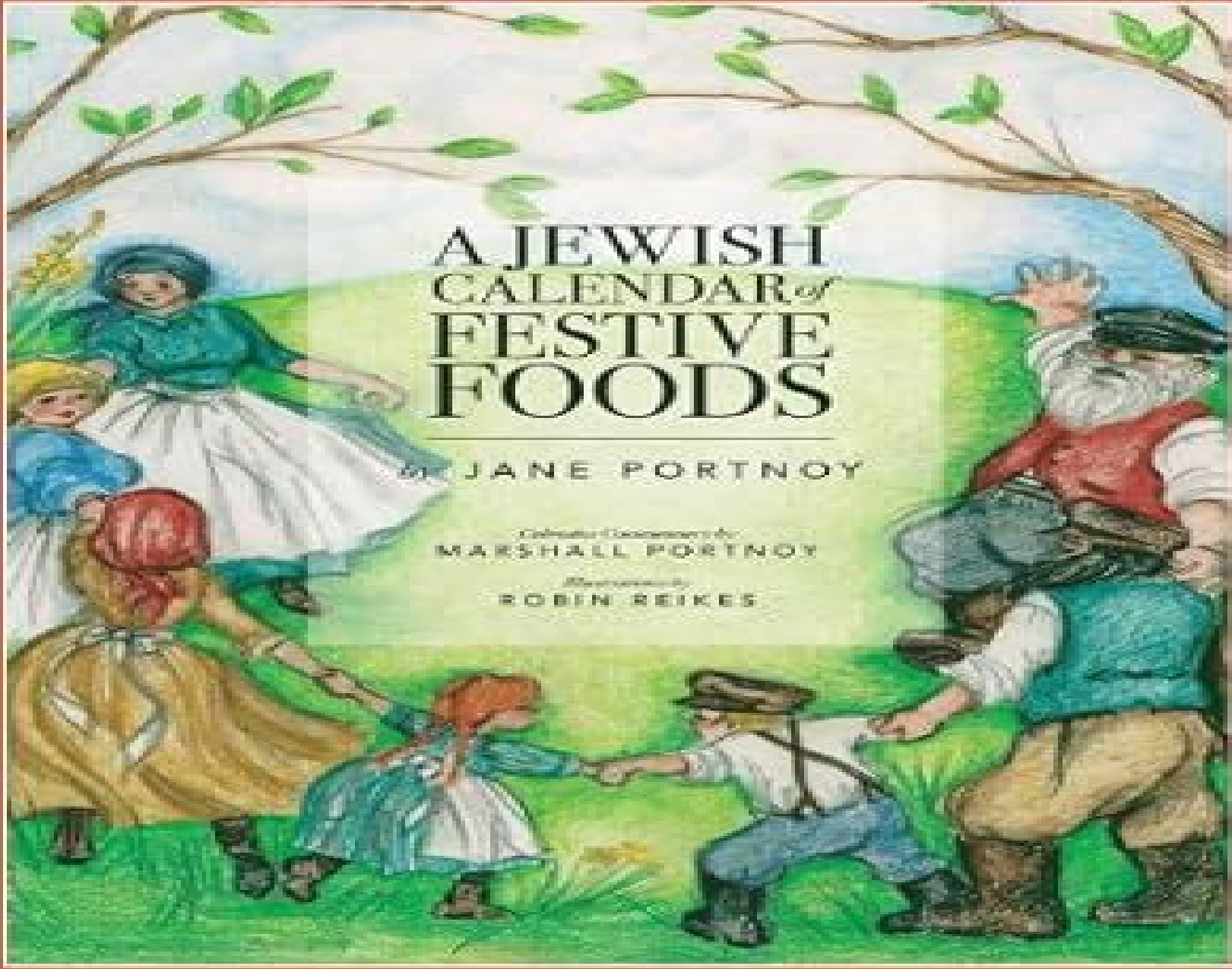

when asked to describe a nutritious diet they could recite the food guide and list rich sources of vitamins and minerals but none of this intellectual knowledge was reflected in their own actual eating habits
