The Huayuanzhuang East corpus is an unusually homogeneous set of more than two thousand five hundred divination records produced over a short period of time on behalf of a prince of the royal family. There are typically multiple records of divinations regarding the same or similar topics that can be synchronized together which not only allows for remarkable access into the esoteric world of divination practice but also produce micro reconstructions of what is essentially East Asia's earliest and most complete day and month planner. Because these texts are unusually linguistically transparent and well preserved, homogeneous in orthography and content and published to an unprecedentedly high standard, they are also ideal material for learning to read and interpret early epigraphic texts. The Huayuanzhuang East oracle bone inscriptions are a tremendously important Shang archive of material documents that were produced by a previously unknown divination and scribal organization. They expose us to an entirely fresh set of perspectives and preoccupations centering on a member of the royal family at the commencement of China's historical period.
