A Weekend with Claude Beryl Bainbridge, 1967 **Understanding Beryl Bainbridge** Brett Josef Grubisic, 2008 This is a comprehensive companion to the novelist's darkly comic social and historical works In this introduction to prolific British novelist Beryl Bainbridge Brett Josef Grubisic provides a biographical sketch of the writer discussion of her motivations and techniques and a detailed survey of her fiction that places the works in the traditions of British black comedy social novels and historical fiction Born near Liverpool in 1934 Bainbridge has explained that her troubled youth was instrumental in her choice to write novels A fractious family discouraging social milieu and wartime deprivations forged the darkly comic perspective that informs Bainbridge's fiction Emerging on the literary scene in the 1970s with widely praised novels such as *The Dressmaker* *The Bottle Factory Outing* *Sweet William* *A Quiet Life* and *Injury Time* Bainbridge quickly established a reputation for her keen observations of social dysfunction and her darkly comic tone In approaching her works Grubisic maps Bainbridge's movement from social to historical novels beginning with the comic historicism of *Young Adolf* and continuing to her most recent fiction *The Birthday Boys* *Every Man for Himself* *Master Georgie* and *According to Queeney* Grubisic holds that in portraying historical events through a variety of narrative techniques or from oblique vantage points Bainbridge's latest novels partially ally themselves with the style and ideological concerns of literary postmodernism while still recalling the defining view of hardship established in her youth

PREFACE ONE Life is a journey How many times have we been reminded of this truism Perhaps by a well meaning friend or a passing bumper sticker only to forget a few moments later as the buzz of self talk resumes and we focus on the immanency of the day The human psyche is wired for survival food clothing and shelter are basic instincts and of course if we can provide a little or a lot more we can change survival into actual living Priorities demand we ease the transition of our journey by doing all of those things we need to do to make life pleasant rather than focusing on the journey itself As John Lennon said Life is what happens when we are busy doing other things Louise Kennedy is one of those remarkable people who are able to examine her life's journey face realistically the bad times remembering them without resentment rather than shutting them out or paving them over Louise has focused on her fascinating journey and recorded it for posterity in this amazing book When Louise and I met for the first time with the goal of examining her manuscript editing proof reading and shaping it for publication I was immediately charmed by her unassuming demeanor and engaging personality As I read through her copious notes I marveled at her tenacious writing skills her excellent memory and the fact that she has survived the abuse sexual trauma alcoholism and tragedy that have been her constant companions to become a whole person She lost three of her children two to accidental death and one to murder One frequently meets what I categorize as the walking wounded especially in the world of writing Many people suffered abuse during childhood and mistakenly believe their story would make a best seller particularly as a result of having been frequently prodded by friends and relatives saying you should write a book In truth very few do write that book for varying reasons which is just as well for very few would make it Louise's story is truly one of survival she has suffered throughout her life It is an odyssey in which is encapsulated an extraordinary determination to exorcise the ghosts of her past and indeed her present despite countless disappointments and obstacles We readers find ourselves rooting for her but as the title suggests she inexplicably continues to make the wrong choices We would be wrong to fall into the trap of her apparent inaction the subterfuge that suggests she was the author of her own fate and why did she do this or she could have easily walked away from that so what's the matter with her Who knows what role fate plays in the spirituality of our choices For most life changing decisions are made in that aura Do we really make them single handedly or are they predetermined I would rather make countless mistakes than fail to make a decision at all thereby becoming a victim of inertia for within each mistake there are a plethora of lessons to be learned Perhaps there is more to Lord Alfred Tennyson's 'Tis better to have loved and lost than never to have loved at all than meets the eye I suspect there are many readers who will identify with Louise as they recognize themselves in her struggles

bleachers till 4 am blissfully enveloped by the heady music of Bird Bud Powell Max Roach and a host of other jazz giants From Birdland to Broadway is an enthralling insider's account of four decades of a life in jazz Bill Crow journeyman bass player superb storyteller and author of the successful Jazz Anecdotes here narrates many moving and delightful tales of the pioneers of modern jazz he played with and was befriended by We find Dizzy Gillespie with whom Crow because of prior commitments regretfully declined steady work dancing at the Royal Roost Stan Getz sadly teetering on the brink of losing himself to drugs and Harry Belafonte known then as the Cinderella Gentleman running a lunch counter in New York's Sheridan Square between music dates And we also witness many of the highlights of Crow's career such as in 1955 when the Marian McPartland Trio with Crow on bass was named Small Group of the Year by Metronome Crow playing with the Gerry Mulligan Quartet at venues like Storyville in Boston and Harlem's Apollo Theater where they appeared with Dinah Washington and the tour of the Soviet Union with Benny Goodman a journey that might have been a high point of Crow's travels abroad but was marred by Goodman's legendary mistreatment of his band Moving beyond jazz clubs to the Broadway concert pit and a variety of studio gigs in the 60s Crow encounters actors such as Yul Brynner and pop rock acts like Simon and Garfunkel From the great to the near great from Billie Holiday to Judy Holliday Bill Crow's wealth of personal anecdotes takes the reader from Birdland to the Half Note to the Playboy Club to the footlights of Broadway This revealing book is a marvelous portrait of the jazz world told by someone who's been there

Nightmare in the Pacific Michael Doyle, 2025-03-17 Artie Shaw took his clarinet to war where he roused the troops and paid the price A pugnacious and strong-willed musician Shaw abandoned civilian celebrity to lead World War II's most colorful navy band on an island hopping odyssey that raised military morale but brought him into dark waters Nightmare in the Pacific The World War II Saga of Artie Shaw and his Navy Band recounts the offbeat wartime adventures of the bandleader and the musicians he recruited for the hard swinging outfit popularly dubbed Shaw's Rangers This team of all stars seasoned pros and promising up-and-comers included the brilliant but troubled drummer Dave Tough the diminutive trumpet master Max Kaminsky and until he jumped ship the composer and piano ace Claude Thornhill Officially designated as Navy Band 501 they were unmatched musically though never exactly squared away The group's eleven-month overseas deployment started with an extended stay as a house band at a Pearl Harbor club for enlisted men The cushy gig turned serious when Shaw's Rangers shipped out on a battleship for the far reaches of New Caledonia the New Hebrides and most fatefully Guadalcanal It was there that the musicians would come under fire and Shaw's own indomitable will would crack

But then in an unexpected and poignant coda the band that Artie Shaw conjured into existence would reach its musical peak once he was out of the picture Tapping a trove of navy personnel files medical records court documents and archival materials as well as contemporary accounts Nightmare in the Pacific combines musical and military history into one unique saga
