Waldorf Education and Anthroposophy 2 Rudolf Steiner, 1996-10 Julian is without doubt one of the most wonderful of all Christian voices She gets greater and greater in my eyes as I grow older Thomas Merton Other than what is contained in her singular work Showings of Divine Love we know almost nothing of the personal life of Julian We do however know something about her background as a recluse or anchoress and the social cultural and political life of late fourteenth century England Although nothing of it is mentioned in her Showings the times in which Julian lived were fraught with political social and economic upheavals in both Church and state There are indeed many parallels to the present age This in part helps to explain why Julian speaks so loudly to today after six hundred years of silence On the thirteenth of May 1373 Julian received a series of sixteen visions centered on the person and sufferings of Jesus and on the Trinity A short time later she wrote an account of them in twenty five chapters known as the Short Text Twenty years later after much prayer and reflection she wrote another account consisting of eighty six chapters called the Long Text During this important interim Julian the visionary became Julian the theologian Julian's visions correspond to the classic understanding of such phenomena Some visions were spiritual locutions In this experience God spoke directly to her heart in such a way as to communicate with absolute unquestioned clarity the desired message Actual words were probably not used but the visionary was left with no doubt as to the authenticity or the meaning of the message Other visions were visual or experienced as coming through the corporeal senses These resulted from the direct action of God on the imagination Still others were spiritual visions not easily expressed and usually concerned with the deeper mysteries of God such as the Trinity Many of Julian's visions were combinations of all three types This book is not a translation or paraphrase of Julian's Showings of Divine Love Rather it is a commentary in 86 brief meditative chapters intended to provide information reflections and further theological understanding that will enhance the modern Christian's reading of Julian's book It can be read independently prior to reading Julian's book or along with it chapter by chapter

Pedagogies of the Imagination Timothy Leonard,Peter Willis,2008-06-11 I have long admired the mythopoetic

tradition in curriculum studies That admiration followed from my experience as a high school teacher of English in a wealthy suburb of New York City at the end of the 1960s A dream job I taught four classes of 15-20 students during a nine period day in a dream suburb where I could afford to reside only by taking a room in a retired teacher's house many of these often Ivy League bound students had everything but meaningful lives This middle class Midwestern young teacher was flabbergasted In one sense my academic life has been devoted to understanding that searing experience Matters of meaning seemed paramount in the curriculum field to which Paul Klohr introduced me at Ohio State Klohr assigned me the work of curriculum theorists such as James B Macdonald Like Timothy Leonard who also studied with Klohr at Ohio State and Peter Willis Macdonald 1995 understood that school reform was part of a broader cultural and political crisis in which meaning is but one casualty In the mythopoetic tradition in curriculum studies scholars labor to understand this crisis and the conditions for the reconstruction of meaning in our time in our schools

young writers to a wide range of poets and the poetic techniques and styles that they have incorporated in their writing. As a result when students complete a series of workshops from this book they will know how to write a poem. They may enjoy reading more poetry too because they will have a solid understanding of how poetry works. Finally there are exciting ideas in *Look Ma Hands on Poetry* for ways in which young writers can exhibit and perform their poetry. The workshops in this book run from 45 to 60 minutes with the time divided into three segments. In the first the teacher reads and discusses poems that are examples of the types of poetry students will be writing. In the second the teacher introduces the writing assignment and has students begin writing. Finally students who finish poems are invited to share them in the remaining class time. Because poetry is the art of capturing experience in language the workshops are structured around sight, smell, taste, touch, and sound. Each of the workshops in the first five chapters is geared toward exploring one of these senses and the two later chapters contain workshops that require students to use all five to write their poems. As a result workshops from each chapter may be used individually or in sequence to create one or two week poetry units that teachers and students can enjoy. Workshops in the book include the Sleight of Hand and Animal Mask Workshops wherein students use metaphor, simile, and personification to create imagery in poems. They use music and musical instruments to help them create sound and rhythm in the Native American Chant and Rap Workshops and then they literally play with words to write Bingo and Multiple Voice Poems. Young people have opportunities to express their feelings through poetry in the Blues Love Potion and Ode Workshops and finally they use their five senses simultaneously when writing Bubble and Rainbow Poems and when they interpret paintings, sculpture, and music in Ekphrastic Poems. The book's final section presents creative ideas for poetry readings, books, and displays. Suggestions for readings include the Poetry Cafe which can incorporate any of the Coffee House, Tea Room, 1950's Diner, and/or Greco Roman Garden venues discussed in this section. Student poetry books and chapbooks complete with student art and photos are described here too along with plans for poetry rainbows, sidewalks, mobiles, and poetry word collections.
