Graduate School in Physics with a strong belief in the American dream and in his eventual success. However, it became evident that his fellow physics students, who mostly came from prestigious northern colleges, were better prepared than he, and their social culture was different from his. He was besieged with loneliness and fears that maybe he was inferior morally and intellectually to his white colleagues. Partially out of desperation, he married an African American girl with whom he separated while she was pregnant for a white mistress, Barbara Goodbody. During Thomas's stay at Minnesota, a vigorous debate was taking place in the United States on the position of African Americans in the country. Thomas entered this debate with other African Americans. The African Americans on campus were divided among those who were for complete assimilation of African Americans in the existing American society, others who sought both assimilation and a revolutionary improved American society, and others who wanted complete separation of the two groups, including division of the territory. Questions of current interracial relationships along with assorted difficulties of African Americans matriculating in predominantly white institutions were frequently discussed. When Thomas was close to graduation and looking for employment, it became clear to him that having a white companion or wife would severely limit their opportunities. After suffering a serious frustration crisis, he made an extraordinary gesture to prove his love for Barbara, then left her.
