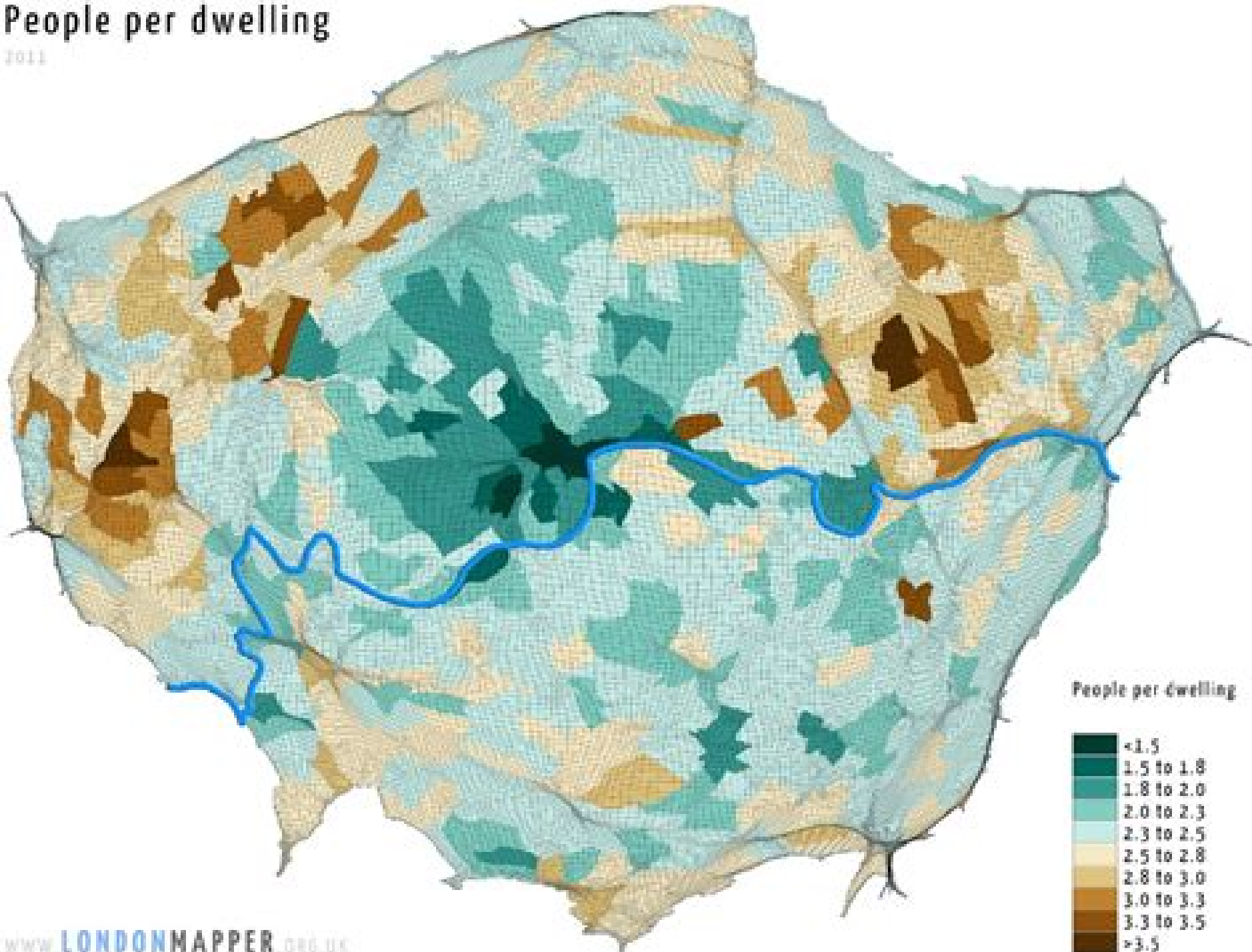

visualization implies using data More widely defined it implies freeing our imaginations The Visualization of Spatial Social Structure introduces the reader to new ways of thinking about how to look at social statistics particularly those about people in places The author presents a unique combination of statistical focus and understanding of social structures and innovations in visualization describing the rationale for and development of a new way of visualizing information in geographical research These methods are illustrated through extensive full colour graphics revealing mistakes techniques and discoveries which present a picture of a changing political and social geography More complex aspects on the surface of social landscapes are revealed with sculptured symbols allowing us to see the relationships between the wood and the trees of social structure Today's software can be so flexible that these techniques can now be emulated without coding This book centres on a particular place and time 1980s Britain and a particular set of records routine social statistics A great deal of information about the 80s social geography of Britain is contained within databases such as the population censuses surveys and administrative data Following the release of the 2011 census now is a good time to look back at the past to introduce many new visualization techniques that could be used by future researchers

Geographical Information Systems GIS either as standard GIS or custom made Historical GIS HGIS have become quite popular in some historical sub disciplines such as Economic and Social History or Historical Geography Mainstream history however seems to be rather unaffected by this trend More generally speaking Why is it that computer applications in general have failed to make much headway in history departments despite the first steps being undertaken a good forty years ago With the spatial turn in full swing in the humanities and many historians dealing with spatial and geographical questions one would think GIS would be welcomed with open arms Yet there seems to be no general anticipation by historians of employing GIS as a research tool As mentioned HGIS are popular chiefly among Historical Geographers and Social and Economic Historians The latter disciplines seem to be predestined to use such software through the widespread quantitativemethodology these disciplines have employed traditionally Other historical sub disciplines such as Ancient History are also very open to this emerging technology since the scarcity of written sources in this field can be mitigated by inferences made from an HGIS that has archaeological data stored in it for example In most of Modern History however the

use of GIS is rarely seen The intellectual benefit that a GIS may bring about seems not be apparent to scholars from this sub discipline and others This book wants to investigate and discuss this controversy Why does the wider historian community not embrace GIS more readily While one cannot deny that the methodologies linked with a GIS follow geographical paradigms rather than historical ones the potential of GIS as a killer application for digital historical scholarship should be obvious This book brings together authors from Geography and History to discuss the value of GIS for historical research The focus however will not be on the how but on the why of GIS in history A Social Geography of England and Wales Richard Dennis, Hugh D. Clout, 1980 *Accidents and Violent Death in Early Modern London, 1650-1750* Craig Spence, 2016

Between the mid seventeenth and mid eighteenth century more than 15 000 Londoners suffered sudden violent deaths While this figure includes around 3 000 who were murdered or committed suicide the vast majority of fatalities resulted from unexplained violent deaths or accidents In the early modern period accidental and disorderly deaths from drowning falls stabbing shooting fires explosions suffocation and animals and vehicles among others were a regular feature of urban life This book is a critical study of the early modern accident Drawing on the weekly London Bills of Mortality parish burial registers newspapers and other related documents it examines accidents and other forms of violent death in the city with a view to understanding who among its residents encountered such events how the bureaucracy recorded and elaborated their circumstances and why they did so and what practical responses might follow Additionally the book explores the way in which these events were transformed to become a recurring cultural trope in oral textual and visual narratives of metropolitan life and how sudden deaths were understood by early modern mentalities By the mid eighteenth century providential explanations were giving way to a more mechanically rational view that saw accident events as threats to be managed rather than misfortunes to be explained

Shakespeare and London Duncan Salkeld, 2018 This volume takes an historical approach to Shakespeare s connections with London It explores Stratford s established links with the capital significant locations for Shakespeare s work the people with whom he associated his resistance to the pressure from the City authorities and the cultural diversity of early modern London Among many features of his life in the City and its environs it covers the playhouses in Shoreditch his associations with Bishopsgate his brother Edmund s residence on Bankside and aspects of London life that went into the making of Falstaff Stratford made the man but London made the phenomenon that is Shakespeare Yet being forest born he was always an outsider and could never have been a citizen We find him repeatedly a sojourner in the City often on the move His home and family lay in Stratford We might almost imagine him a reluctant Londoner Shakespeare and London draws on a range of documentary sources including City parish registers and the archives of London s Bridewell Hospital and seeks to acknowledge those who inhabited Shakespeare s milieu or played some part in shaping his writing and acting career This volume is Ideal reading for undergraduates graduates and specialists of Shakespeare studies
