Lawrence Abel,2015-06-14 During the American Civil War songs united and inspired people on both sides The North had a well established music publishing industry when the war broke out but the South had no such industry The importance of music as an expression of the South s beliefs was obvious as one music publisher said The South must not only fight her own battles but sing her own songs and dance to music composed by her own children Southern entrepreneurs quickly rose to the challenge This reference book is distinguished by three major differences from previously published works First it lists sheet music that is no longer extant and listed nowhere else Second it gives complete lyrics for all extant songs a rich source for researchers And third a brief historical background has been provided for many of the

songs Each entry provides as much of the following as possible staying faithful to the typography of each title page the title as published names of all lyricists composers and publishers dates of publication cities of publication and if applicable the names of catalogs or magazines in which the song appeared Music published in Southern cities under Federal occupation is excluded

Lindquist, 2012 Black Social Science and the Crisis of Manhood 1890 1970 describes the young black male crisis why we are largely unfamiliar with the story of the black superman and why this matters to contemporary debates It does so by returning to the work of those original black social scientists to explore the ways in which they understood the challenges of black manhood offered substantive critiques of the nation's race class and gender systems and worked to construct a progression The careful study of their work reveals the centrality of gender to discussions of race and class and also new possibilities for understanding and discussing black men This book offers a look at pioneering black social scientists as well as a history of the changing perceptions ideals and shifting depictions of black and white manhood over nearly a century

We are Coming Shirley Wilson Logan, 1999 Shirley Wilson Logan analyzes the distinctive rhetorical features in the persuasive discourse of nineteenth century black women concentrating on the public discourse of club and church women from 1880 until 1900 Logan develops each chapter in this illustrated study around a feature of public address as best exemplified in the oratory of a particular woman speaker of the era She analyzes not only speeches but also editorials essays and letters Logan first focuses on the prophetic oratory of Maria Stewart the first American born black woman to speak publicly Turning to Frances Harper she considers speeches that argue for common interests between divergent communities And she demonstrates that central to the antilynching rhetoric of Ida Wells is the concept of presence or the tactic of enhancing certain selected elements of the presentation In her discussion of Fannie Barrier Williams and Anna Cooper Logan shows that when speaking to white club women and black clergymen both Williams and Cooper employ what Kenneth Burke called identification To analyze the rhetoric of Victoria Matthews she applies Carolyn Miller's modification of Lloyd Bitzer's concept of the rhetorical situation Logan also examines the discourse of women associated with the black Baptist women's movement and those participating in college affiliated conferences The book includes an appendix with little known speeches and essays by Anna Julia Cooper Selena Sloan Butler Lucy Wilmot Smith Mary V Cook Adella Hunt Logan Victoria Earle Matthews Lucy C Laney and Georgia Swift King
