Thomas More's Vocation Frank Mitjans, 2023-01-31 The book considers Thomas More's early life choices An early letter is cited by biographers but most miss More's reference to the market place More's great grandson Cresacre a Londoner understood it correctly and that gives reason to trust him on other aspects of More's youth This study is based on early testimonies those of Erasmus Roper Harpsfield Stapleton and Cresacre More as well as More's early writings the Pageant Verses and his additions omissions to the Life of Pico evidence drawn from authors he recommended like Hilton and Gerson and finally his epitaph Attention is given to his lectures on St Augustine's City of God and to St John Chrysostom It is argued More studied Chrysostom's Homilies on the Gospel of St Matthew i from a Greek manuscript Chrysostom in the introductory homily spoke of the city and the market place as the setting in which Christians practice the teaching of Christ More practiced law and taught it He was attracted to becoming a Christian humanist alongside Grocyn Colet Linacre and Lily With them he studied Greek the classics and Fathers of the Church Helped by them he became a man of prayer aware of the need to seek holiness in the midst of the world as a layman Faced with the dilemma of the humanist in choosing between the contemplative life of the philosopher and an active life of engagement with the world he deliberately chose the active life in service to society and the contemplative life of the Christian as a married man This awareness and choice is what is called vocation implying determination to persevere throughout life More saw his life as a pilgrimage towards heaven as described in the last chapter focusing on More's last work *De tristitia tedio pavore et oratione christi ante captionem eius*

Thomas More's Trial by Jury Henry Ansgar Kelly, Louis W. Karlin, Gerard Wegemer, 2011 This book challenges the recently established consensus that the trial was a carefully prepared and executed judicial process in which the judges were amenable to reasonable arguments Thomas More's treason trial in 1535 is one of history's most famous court cases yet never before have all the major documents been collected translated and analyzed by a team of legal and Tudor scholars This edition serves as an important sourcebook and concludes with a docudrama reconstructing the course of the trial based on these documents Legal experts H A Kelly and R H Helmholtz take different approaches to the legalities of this trial and four experienced judges including Justice of the Queen's Bench Sir Michael Tugendhat discuss the trial with some disagreements notably on the meaning and requirement of malice called for in the Parliamentary Act of Supremacy More's own accounts of his interrogations in prison are analyzed and the trial's procedures are compared to and contrasted with 16th century concepts of natural law and also modern judicial practices and principles

The book is a must read not only for students of law and Tudor history but also for all concerned with justice and due process. As a whole the book challenges Duncan Derrett's conclusions that the trial was conducted in accord with contemporary legal norms and that More was convicted only on the single charge of denying Parliament the power to declare Henry VIII Supreme Head of the English Church testified to by Richard Rich a position that has been uniformly accepted by historians since 1964.
