continues the line of thinking of the first book but takes it further through a range of chapters from leading international thinkers on resilience and health care Where the first book provided the rationale and basic concepts of RHC the Resilience of Everyday Clinical Work breaks new ground by analysing everyday work situations in primary secondary and tertiary care to identify and describe the fundamental strategies that clinicians everywhere have developed and use with a fluency that belies the demands to be resolved and the dilemmas to be balanced Because everyday clinical work is at the heart of resilience it is essential to appreciate how it functions and to understand its characteristics
