4.1 Writing Equations in Slope-Intercept Form

Write an equation of the line in slope-intercept form.



Find the slope and y -intercept.

Let $(x_1, y_1) = (0, 3)$ and $(x_2, y_2) = (3, 5)$.

$$m = \frac{y_2 - y_1}{x_2 - x_1} = \frac{5 - 3}{3 - 0} = \frac{2}{3}$$

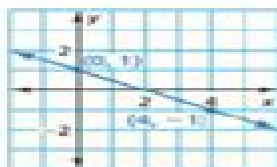
Because the line crosses the y -axis at $(0, 3)$, the y -intercept is 3.

► So, the equation is $y = \frac{2}{3}x + 3$.

4.2 Writing Equations of Lines in Point-Slope Form

Write an equation in point-slope form of the line that passes through the point $(-1, -8)$ and has a slope of 3.

$$y - y_1 = m(x - x_1)$$

Write the point-slope form.

$$y - (-8) = 3[x - (-1)]$$

Substitute 3 for m , -1 for x_1 , and -8 for y_1 .

$$y + 8 = 3(x + 1)$$

Simplify.

► The equation is $y + 8 = 3(x + 1)$.
