**Stolen Dreams** Chris Lamb, 2022-04 When the eleven and twelve year olds on the Cannon Street YMCA All Star team registered for a baseball tournament in Charleston South Carolina in June 1955 it put the team and the forces of integration on a collision course with segregation bigotry and the southern way of life White teams refused to take the field with the Cannon Street All Stars the first Black Little League team in South Carolina The Cannon Street team won the tournament by forfeit and advanced to the state tournament When all the white teams withdrew in protest the Cannon Street team won the state tournament If the team had won the regional tournament in Rome Georgia it would have advanced to the Little League World Series But Little League officials ruled the team ineligible to play in the tournament because it had advanced by winning on forfeit and not on the field denying the boys their dream of playing in the Little League World Series Little League Baseball invited the Cannon Street All Stars to be the organization s guests at the World Series where they heard spectators yell Let them play Let them play when the ballplayers were introduced This became a national story for a few weeks but then faded and disappeared as Americans read of other civil rights stories

including the torture and murder of fourteen year old Emmett Till Stolen Dreams is the story of the Cannon Street YMCA All Stars and of the early civil rights movement It s also the story of centuries of bigotry in Charleston South Carolina where millions of enslaved people were brought to this country and where the Civil War began where segregation remained for a century after the war ended and anyone who challenged it did so at their own risk **A Life on the Middle West's**

**Never-Ending Frontier** Willard L. The book documents the history of every one of his paternal ancestors who lived in several parts of the world from the 16th century to the present They include the son of an African chief an Afro Portuguese Filipino serf whose fathers sailed with Portuguese explorers to Asia and the second wealthiest nonwhite property owner in Halifax County North Carolina To further document the history William traveled to Africa Southeast Asia Europe and to the American locations where these male ancestors lived Using his camera face to face interviews and such rarified sources as the Virginia Carolorum England Birth and Christenings 1538 1975 Database and of course U S Federal and local census records since 1790 and other sources William documents his fascinating story with over 300 endnotes court cases and photographs This material explains the history of his ancestors since the early 16th century in Africa and goes on to explore the life of his ancestral Mbundu family who escaped the Atlantic Slave Trade and lived among the Black Rocks Pedras Negras of today s northern Angola History in My Bones is an unusual story of free and enslaved African American ancestors written in a way no other African American has dared to before now

An Immigrant Bishop Patrick W. Carey, 2022-01-07 An Immigrant Bishop is a revised examination of the Irish intellectual roots of Bishop John England s American pastoral works in the diocese of Charleston South Carolina 1820 1842 The text focuses on his political philosophy and his theology of the Church both of which were influenced by the Enlightenment and a theological not a political Gallicanism As the study demonstrates we now know more about England s intellectual life prior to his immigration than we do about any other Catholic immigrant from Ireland Neither Peter Guilday s monumental two volume biography 1927 of England nor any subsequent scholarly study of England has uncovered and analyzed as this book does England s many unpublished and published writings in Ireland his explicitly authored texts his published speeches before the Cork Aggregate meetings and his pseudonymous articles in the Cork Mercantile Chronicle between 1808 when he was ordained and 1820 when he emigrated to the United States John England 1786 1842 the first Catholic bishop of Charleston was the foremost national spokesman for Catholicism in the United States during the years of his episcopacy and the primary apologist for the compatibility of Catholicism and American republicanism He was also the first Catholic bishop to speak before the United States Congress and the first American to receive a papal appointment as an Apostolic Delegate to a foreign country in this case to negotiate a concordat with President Jean Pierre Boyer of Haiti He is considered the father of the Baltimore Provincial Councils and the nineteenth century American Catholic conciliar tradition He was also the only bishop in American history to develop a constitutional form of diocesan government and administration Among other things he was the first cleric to establish a diocesan newspaper that had something of a national distribution England s contribution to the early formation of an American Catholicism has been told many times before but he has the kind of creative mind and episcopal leadership that demands repeated re considerations
