Educating for Professional Life Elaine Penn, 2017-09-26 The story of the University of Westminster is the fifth volume in a series of titles exploring the University's long and diverse history. MAPPING CONFLICT IN CHITTAGONG HILL TRACTS 1997-2014 Zahid ul Arefin Choudhury, 2020-04-27 The issue of the Chittagong Hill Tracts is as divisive as the region itself. At one end, there are tales of woe: how the original inhabitants of the region are being evicted from their land through violence and trickery; their marginalization and elimination of their traditional way of life simultaneously while it is being exoticized for tourism. These accounts, however, paint a static picture where the members of these ethnic groups are victims always and without any agency. Consequently, these accounts fail to hold up in front of close examination and invite counter opinion: rage that the Bengali and other ethnicities of CHT are prevented from living in harmony by disruptive elements within the society; that the oppression and repression of the hill peoples are made up stories that feed national and international conspiracies. In *Conflict Mapping in the Chittagong Hill Tracts*, researchers from the Department of Peace and Conflict Studies at the University of Dhaka cut through this fog of confusion by presenting dispassionate, unornamented data. With the help of original data and systematic analysis, they show how the social life of CHT is marked by deep polarization both within and across the ethnic divide; how it is beset by real and perceived accounts of discrimination and by lack of confidence in state agencies and the rule of law. They also investigate the trajectory of major cases of violence in the region in the past two decades and reveal that these have a common escalation pattern with various points marked by missed opportunities for prevention. Based on a study that draws from a large survey of a cross section of people from 8 of the most crime prone Upazilas of the region, semi structured interviews of selected elites and analysis of the dynamics of 14 incidents of large scale violence between 1997 and 2014, this book aims at initiating a healthy, constructive conversation on the issue. It challenges long held prejudices, common sense beliefs and unsubstantiated propaganda. By offering the lens of social science, the book invites readers with well meaning but vague opinions, as well as consumers of zealous and spoon fed ideas, to form informed and nuanced opinions.

Rury, 2023-10-13 An Age of Accountability highlights the role of test based accountability as a policy framework in American education from 1970 to 2020 For more than half a century the quest to hold schools and educators accountable for academic achievement has relied almost exclusively on standardized assessment The theory of change embedded in almost all test based accountability programs held that assessment with stipulated consequences could lead to major improvements in schools This was accomplished politically by proclaiming lofty goals of attaining universal proficiency and closing achievement gaps which repeatedly failed to materialize But even after very clear disappointments no other policy framework has emerged to challenge its hegemony The American public today has little confidence in institutions to improve the quality of goods and services they provide especially in the public sector As a consequence many Americans continue to believe that accountability remains a vital necessity even if educators and policy scholars disagree

Assured Destruction David Bath, 2020-03-15 Assured Destruction Building the Ballistic Missile Culture of the U S Air Force documents the rapid development of nuclear ballistic missiles in the United States and their equally swift demise after the Cuban Missile Crisis revealing how these drastic changes negatively influenced both the Air Force and the missile community David W Bath contends that the struggle to create and control nuclear ballistic missiles threatened both the dominance of the United States during an intensifying Cold War and the strategic airpower mission of the newly created Air Force The book details the strenuous efforts required to create and prepare a missile arsenal before the Cuban Missile Crisis which occurred only five

years after the first missile was declared operational It uses the personal recollections of former missileers and the professional military education theses they wrote to highlight some of the concerns that have faced the missileers who operated and worked on these powerful weapons from 1957 to the present The highlight of the book however is the personal stories of the missileers who served during the missile crisis revealing the efforts that they went to in order to prepare these unique and untried weapons for what many thought might become the third world war Using Graywater and Stormwater to Enhance Local Water Supplies National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Division on Earth and Life Studies, Water Science and Technology Board, Committee on the Beneficial Use of Graywater and Stormwater: An Assessment of Risks, Costs, and Benefits, 2016-07-30 Chronic and episodic water shortages are becoming common in many regions of the United States and population growth in water scarce regions further compounds the challenges Increasingly alternative water sources such as graywater untreated wastewater that does not include water from the toilet but generally includes water from bathroom sinks showers bathtubs clothes washers and laundry sinks and stormwater water from rainfall or snow that can be measured downstream in a pipe culvert or stream shortly after the precipitation event are being viewed as resources to supplement scarce water supplies rather than as waste to be discharged as rapidly as possible Graywater and stormwater can serve a range of non potable uses including irrigation toilet flushing washing and cooling although treatment may be needed Stormwater may also be used to recharge groundwater which may ultimately be tapped for potable use In addition to providing additional sources of local water supply harvesting stormwater has many potential benefits including energy savings pollution prevention and reducing the impacts of urban development on urban streams Similarly the reuse of graywater can enhance water supply reliability and extend the capacity of existing wastewater systems in growing cities Despite the benefits of using local alternative water sources to address water demands many questions remain that have limited the broader application of graywater and stormwater capture and use In particular limited information is available on the costs benefits and risks of these projects and beyond the simplest applications many state and local public health agencies have not developed regulatory frameworks for full use of these local water resources To address these issues Using Graywater and Stormwater to Enhance Local Water Supplies analyzes the risks costs and benefits on various uses of graywater and stormwater This report examines technical economic regulatory and social issues associated with graywater and stormwater capture for a range of uses including non potable urban uses irrigation and groundwater recharge Using Graywater and Stormwater to Enhance Local Water Supplies considers the quality and suitability of water for reuse treatment and storage technologies and human health and environmental risks of water reuse The findings and recommendations of this report will be valuable for water managers citizens of states under a current drought and local and state health and environmental agencies EU Global Strategy and Human Security Mary Kaldor, Iavor Rangelov, Sabine Selchow, 2018-04-17 This volume examines the EU's Global Strategy in relation to human security approaches to conflict

The Southern Manifesto John Kyle Day, 2014-07-09. On March 13, 1956, ninety-nine members of the United States Congress promulgated the Declaration of Constitutional Principles, popularly known as the Southern Manifesto. Reprinted here, the Southern Manifesto formally stated opposition to the landmark United States Supreme Court decision *Brown v Board of Education* and the emergent civil rights movement. This statement allowed the white South to prevent *Brown*'s immediate full-scale implementation and for nearly two decades set the slothful timetable and glacial pace of public school desegregation. The Southern Manifesto also provided the Southern Congressional Delegation with the means to stymie federal voting rights legislation so that the dismantling of Jim Crow could be managed largely on white southern terms. In the wake of the *Brown* decision that declared public school segregation unconstitutional, seminal events in the early stages of the
