Section 1: Native Peoples in the Americas

- **Native Peoples Develop Diverse Cultures**
 - Debate over when and how the first people came, most likely from NE Asia
 - Believed a growth of glaciers between 38,000 and 14,000 B.C. led to a drop in sea levels and created a land bridge in the Bering Strait, known as **Beringia**
 - First people likely came over 20,000 to 25,000 years ago during a warming trend following mammoths, moose, bison, and wholly rhinoceroses
 - Eventually, ice returned, and migrants pushed inland
 - Mammoths disappeared approx. 10,000; people became dependent on fish, plants, other meats to survive
 - Some communities began establishing agriculture, led to permanent settlements
 - Horticulture- people working on small plots of land with simple tools- developed in present-day Mexico
 - Beans, squash, and corn offered a well-rounded diet
 - High yields produced surpluses of food allowed for trade
 - Led to economic developments and diversification of societies
 - Small bands of hunters and gatherers in deserts and forests
 - Civilizations on wetlands, grasslands, and mountains
- **The Aztecs, Mayas, and the Incas**
 - Large, wealthy civilizations that were dominant in the 15th century
 - **Aztecs** (Mexico) built Tenochtitlan (present day Mexico City)
 - Used irrigation and cultivation, developed written language
 - Class structure: priests and nobles
 - Nobles- warrior class, landowners, employed serfs and slaves
 - Priests- promised fertility, demanded human sacrifices
 - Vast trade networks
 - **Mayans** settled the Yucatan peninsula and rainforests (present day Guatemala)
 - Large cities with elaborate water storage systems
 - Built large palaces for the Gods
 - Learned mathematics, astronomy, hieroglyphics, and calendars
 - Began to decline around 800 A.D.
 - Likely the result of drought and heavy taxation
 - Began trading with the Aztecs
 - The **Incas** settled in the Andes Mountains
 - Had extensive road and garrison systems
 - Fertile mountain valleys allowed for crops
 - Gold, silver, and irrigation systems
 - Human sacrifice to keep natural disasters and military defeat away

from his hometown of Massillon Ohio to the steps of the nation's Capitol Though a financial panic and the resulting widespread business failures caused millions of Americans to be without work at the time the word unemployment was rarely used and generally misunderstood In an era that worshipped the self-reliant individual who triumphed in a laissez faire market the out-of-work tramp was disparaged as weak or flawed and undeserving of assistance Private charities were unable to meet the needs of the jobless and only a few communities experimented with public works programs Despite these limitations Coxe conceived a plan to put millions back to work building a nationwide system of roads and drew attention to his idea with the march to Washington In Coxe's Crusade for Jobs Jerry Prout recounts Coxe's story and adds depth and context by focusing on the reporters who were embedded in the march Their fascinating depictions of life on the road occupied the headlines and front pages of America's newspapers for more than a month turning the spectacle into a serialized drama These accounts humanized the idea of unemployment and helped Americans realize that in a new industrial economy unemployment was not going away and the unemployed deserved attention This unique study will appeal to scholars and students interested in the Gilded Age and US and labor history *An American Odyssey* Mary Schmidt

Campbell, 2018-08-06 By the time of his death in 1988 Romare Bearden was most widely celebrated for his large-scale public murals and collages which were reproduced in such places as Time and Esquire to symbolize and evoke the black experience in America As Mary Schmidt Campbell shows us in this definitive defining and immersive biography the relationship between art and race was central to his life and work a constant driving creative tension Bearden started as a cartoonist during his college years but in the later 1930s turned to painting and became part of a community of artists supported by the WPA As his reputation grew he perfected his skills studying the European masters and analyzing and breaking down their techniques finding new ways of applying them to the America he knew one in which the struggle for civil rights became all-absorbing By the time of the March on Washington in 1963 he had begun to experiment with the Projections as he called his major collages in which he tried to capture the full spectrum of the black experience from the grind of daily life to broader visions and aspirations Campbell's book offers a full and vibrant account of Bearden's life his years in Harlem his studio was above the Apollo theater to his travels and commissions along with illuminating analysis of his work and artistic career Campbell who met Bearden in the 1970s was among the first to compile a catalogue of his works *An American Odyssey* goes far beyond that offering a living portrait of an artist and the impact he made upon the world he sought both to recreate and celebrate
