

Bourgeois, 2023-08-04 Every DSM 5 diagnosis includes an exclusion criterion that the disorder is not better explained by a medical condition Meeting this criterion can be difficult for a variety of reasons The psychiatric signs and symptoms of medical disorders are not commonly emphasized in medical textbooks Further illness scripts for medical diagnoses do not often overlap with psychiatric disorders making it difficult to know what medical conditions should be ruled out For example irritability is a common symptom in polycystic ovarian disorder but PCOS is rarely on the differential for irritability Similarly while hypothyroidism is commonly linked to the illness script of depression patients with MDD may be just as likely to have diabetes an infrequently considered diagnosis for depression Buzzword
