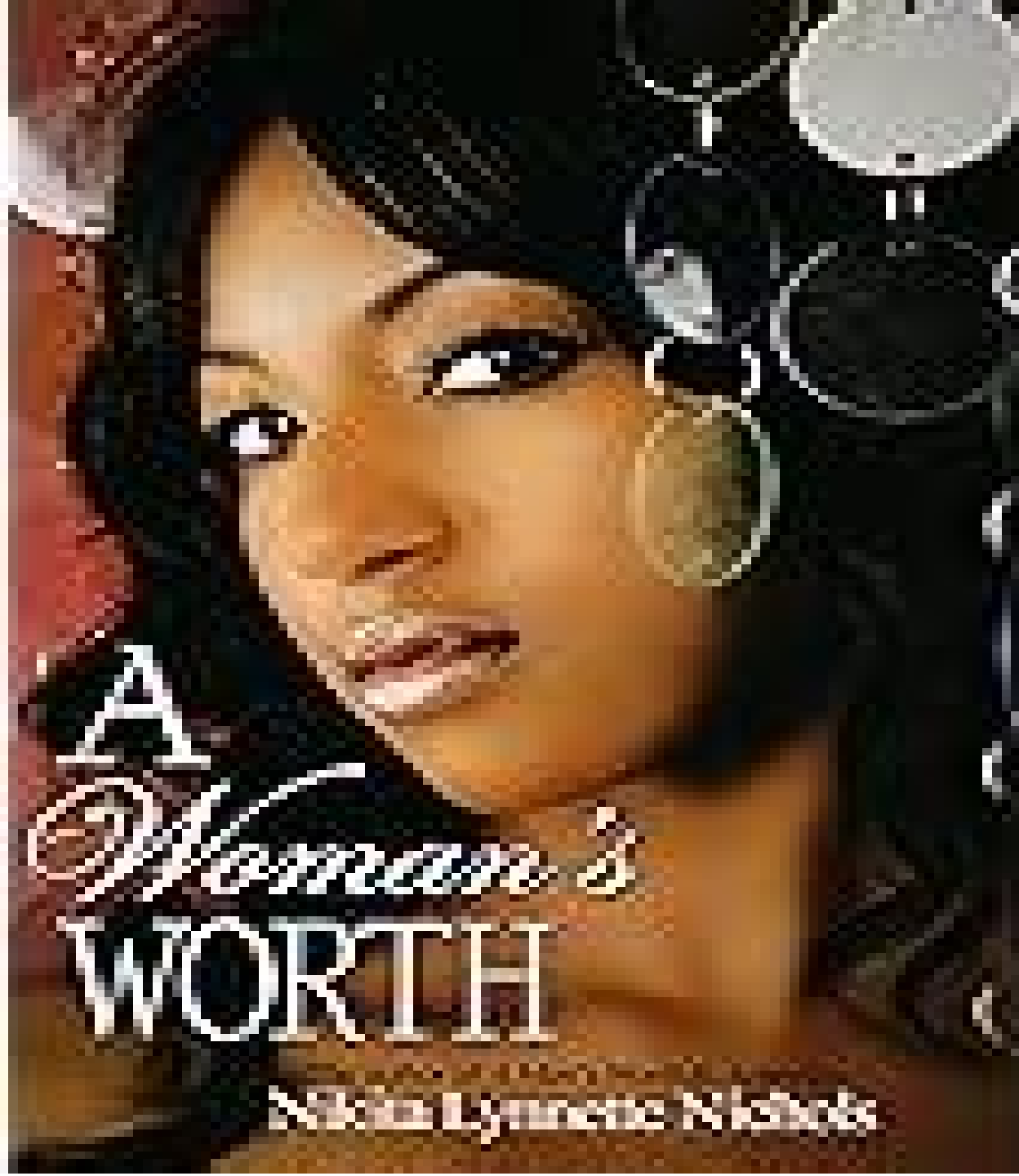

George Gissing, the Working Woman, and Urban Culture Emma Liggins, 2017-09-29 George Gissing s work reflects his observations of fin de si cle London life Influenced by the French naturalist school his realist representations of urban culture testify to the significance of the city for the development of new class and gender identities particularly for women Liggins s study which considers standard texts

such as *The Odd Women*, *New Grub Street* and *The Nether World* as well as lesser known short works examines Gissing's fiction in relation to the formation of these new identities focusing specifically on debates about the working woman. From the 1880s onward a new genre of urban fiction increasingly focused on work as a key aspect of the modern woman's identity, elements of which were developed in the New Woman fiction of the 1890s. Showing his fascination with the working woman and her narrative potential, Gissing portrays women from a wide variety of occupations ranging from factory girls, actresses, prostitutes and shop girls to writers, teachers, clerks and musicians. Liggins argues that by placing the working woman at the center of his narratives rather than at the margins, Gissing made an important contribution to the development of urban fiction which increasingly reflected current debates about women's presence in the city.

Women's Work and Rights in Early Modern Urban Europe Anna Bellavitis, 2018-10-09 In the last decades, women's role in the workforce has dramatically changed, though gender inequality persists and for women, gender identity still prevails over work identity. It is important not to forget or diminish the historical role of women in the labour market, though, and this book proposes a critical overview of the most recent historical research on women's roles in economic urban activities. Covering a wide area of early modern Europe from Portugal to Poland and from Scandinavia to the Mediterranean, Bellavitis presents an overview of the economic rights of women, property inheritance, management of their wealth, access to the guilds, access to education and assesses the evolution of female work in different urban contexts.

Gender and Planning Susan S. Fainstein, Lisa J. Servon, 2005 To document and analyze the connection between gender and planning, the editors of this volume have assembled an interdisciplinary collection of influential essays by leading scholars. Contributors point to the ubiquitous single family home which prevents women from sharing tasks or pooling services. Similarly, they argue that public transportation routes are usually designed for the male worker's commute from home to the central city and do not help the suburban dweller running errands. In addition to these practical considerations, many contributors offer theoretical perspectives on issues such as planning discourse and the construction of concepts of rationality.

This Woman's Work Osizwe Raena Jamila Harwell, 2016-06-07 This *Woman's Work* presents a social history and critical biography based on the life of award-winning writer Bebe Moore Campbell (1950-2006). It offers the personal story of a popular novelist, journalist and mental health advocate. This book examines Campbell's life and activism in two periods: first as a student at the University of Pittsburgh during the 1960s black student movement and second as a mental health advocate near the end of her life in 2006.

It describes Campbell's activism within the Black Action Society from 1967 to 1971 and her negotiation of the Black Nationalist ideologies espoused during the 1960s. The book also explores Campbell's later involvement in the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), her role as a national spokesperson and the local activism that sparked the birth of the NAMI Urban Los Angeles chapter which served black and Latino communities. 1999-2006 Adjacent to her activist work, Campbell's first novel *Your Blues Ain't Like Mine* connects to her emerging political consciousness related to race and gender and the concern for racial violence during the US black liberation period from 1950 to 1970.
