The Iron Heart Reinhard Heydrich Johana Connor, Reinhard Tristan Eugen Heydrich known to the Nazis as The Blond Beast and to others as Hangman Heydrich was the main architect of Hitler's Final Solution and one among the main architects of the Holocaust in which the Nazis intended to destroy the entire Jewish population of Europe Heydrich was a cold calculating manipulator without empathy Heydrich was described as a guy with ruthless brave and cold intelligence for whom truth and goodness had no fundamental significance Heydrich's attitude was so icy and cold blooded that even other Nazis found it unsettling He joined the Nazi party in June 1931 and became a

member of the SA a gang of thugs that engaged in street fights and bar brawls with communists He stood out as one of Nazi Germany's cruelest and most heinous mass killers Both those who worked for Heydrich and those unlucky enough to be subjected to his influence feared him Heydrich's primary responsibility was the murder of many Jews and other enemies of the Reich A monument was built in memory of Heydrich's killers by their surviving comrades Even though Heydrich was assassinated in 1942 at the age of 38 his influence permeated every aspect of Nazi Germany One of the most vicious Nazi war criminals of the Holocaust the man who believed it was his job to save the world from intellectual and moral degradation has gained notoriety since the war Was this to be the leader of the third reich or hatred towards the Jews Get yourself the book to know the brutal stories of the blond beast who drove the anti Jewish policies **Holocaust Memory Reframed**
