The cosmos to me is an illusory field. Beyond the concept of Cosmos lies the web wave field which is discussed extensively in this book. All our scope, our sciences and philosophy, particularly life, death, rebirth beliefs pertain to the body which gets the illusion because the body is matter. Vedas and Adi Shankar Acharya call illusion as Maya and consciousness as Prajnaa. The illusion has to be perfect for all of us during the illusory life giving us the utmost happiness in all walks of this life. Everything to us happens only in illusion and so we must evoke the divine power to be happy in this illusion in the short life and thereafter free us from this illusory world. On this score the invocation of divine or cosmic energies are absolutely a must. Though it is easier to talk about illusion in theory in practical life it is not easy. Either everyone has their daily routine to follow like attending their work, begetting children, raising children, getting them married, owning property, engagement in business or agriculture or profession and so on.
