American Xenophobia and the Slav Immigrant Josephine Wtulich, 1994 *The Films of Clint Eastwood* Matt Wanat, Leonard Engel, 2018-05-15 The indefatigable Clint Eastwood the great old man of American film is still controversial after all these years Many of the critical essays in this collection focus on Eastwood's 2014 *American Sniper* a particularly controversial film and a devastating personal account of the horrors of war Additional essays within the collection address his films that deserve more recognition than they have received to date The chapters vary by topic and identify themes ranging from aging race and gender to uses of Western conventions and myth to the subtleties of quieter themes and stylistic choices in Eastwood's body of cinematic work As a collection these essays show that none of these themes account for Eastwood's entire vision which is multifaceted and often contradictory dramatizing complex issues in powerful character driven narratives

Origins of the Warfare State Carl Boggs, 2016-08-12 The post World War II emergence of a full blown state of perpetual war is arguably the most important feature of contemporary American politics This book examines the warfare state in terms of a broad ensemble of structures policies and ideologies permanent war economy national security state global expansion of military bases merger of state corporate and military power an imperial presidency the nuclear establishment and superpower ambitions Carl Boggs makes the argument that the Good War led to an authoritarian system that has expanded throughout the post war decades undermining liberal democratic institutions and values in the process He goes on to suggest that current American electoral politics show no sign of rolling back the warfare state and in fact may push it to a new threshold bordering on American fascism

Monstrous Fantasies Leila K. Norako, 2024-08-15 *Monstrous Fantasies* asks why medieval romances reimagining the crusades ending in a Christian victory circulated in England with such abundance after the 1291 Muslim reconquest of Acre the last of the Latin crusader states in the Holy Land and what these texts reveal about the cultural anxieties of late medieval England Leila K Norako highlights the impact that the Ottoman victory and subsequent massacre of Christian prisoners at the battle of Nicopolis in 1396 had on intensifying the popularity of what she calls recovery romance These two episodes inspired a sense of urgency over the fate of the Holy Land and of Latin Christendom itself resulting in the proliferation of romances in which crusading English kings like Richard I and anachronistic legends like King Arthur not only reconquered Jerusalem but committed genocidal violence against the Muslims These romances which as Norako argues also influenced Geoffrey Chaucer's *Canterbury Tales* conjure fantasies of an ascendant global Christendom by rehearsing acts of conquest and cultural annihilation that were impossible to realize in the late Middle Ages Emphasizing the tension in these texts between nostalgia and anticipation that fuels their narrative momentum *Monstrous Fantasies* also explores how the cultural desires for European and Christian hegemony that recovery romances versified were revived in the wake of the so called wars on terror in the twenty first century in such films as *Kingdom of Heaven* and *American Sniper*

Islamophobia in Higher Education Shafiqah Ahmadi, Darnell Cole, 2023-07-03 While Islamophobia was present in our society before 9 11 it has become more pervasive in recent years This is evidenced by the current social and political climate hate speech and hate crimes directed at Muslims and the Supreme Court's upholding of Presidential Proclamation 645 that effectively bans Muslim immigration from coming to the U S What does this mean for Muslim students in college and indeed for institutions of higher education as they navigate law and policy on the one hand and adhere to their mission of achieving inclusive and equitable educational environments on the other Two thirds of Muslims in the U S are vexed with current policy and there has been an alarming increase in reports of bigotry and discrimination against them since the 2016 presidential elections The fear of Islam in general and Muslims specifically not only compels non Muslims to differentially treat Muslims but also trade some of their own civil rights and civil liberties under the guise of national security To address these issues institutions require a nuanced understanding of laws and policies that institutionalize Islamophobia and a greater understanding of the diverse college students that identify as Muslim This book fills what has been a dearth of research that explores the experiences and navigation of Muslim students in colleges and universities and addresses the even less studied domain of the experiences of Muslim students who hold multiple marginalized identities such as race ethnicity and LGBTQ status as well as the intersection of those identities that may create multiple burdens of oppression and discrimination This book begins by critically engaging with how current laws and policies institutionalize Islamophobia and affect the intersectionality and diversity within the Muslim community It includes multidisciplinary voices such as an international human rights attorney a civil rights attorney a criminal law attorney student affairs practitioners and research faculty whose work on this marginalized student population is traditionally not recognized within academic settings and brings the voices of female Muslim scholars to the fore Each chapter includes a critical analysis of the literature a legal analysis when

History and Museums Division, 1977 **The OSS and Ho Chi Minh** Dixee Bartholomew-Feis, 2006-05-12 Some will be shocked to find out that the United States and Ho Chi Minh our nemesis for much of the Vietnam War were once allies Indeed during the last year of World War II American spies in Indochina found themselves working closely with Ho Chi Minh and other anti colonial factions compelled by circumstances to fight together against the Japanese Dixee Bartholomew Feis reveals how this relationship emerged and operated and how it impacted Vietnam s struggle for independence The men of General William Donovan s newly formed Office of Strategic Services closely collaborated with communist groups in both Europe and Asia against the Axis enemies In Vietnam this meant that OSS officers worked with Ho Chi Minh and the Viet Minh whose ultimate aim was to rid the region of all imperialist powers not just the Japanese Ho for his part did whatever he could to encourage the OSS s negative view of the French who

were desperate to regain their colony Revealing details not previously known about their covert operations Bartholomew Feis chronicles the exploits of these allies as they developed their network of informants sabotaged the Japanese occupation s infrastructure conducted guerrilla operations and searched for downed American fliers and Allied POWs Although the OSS did not bring Ho Chi Minh to power Bartholomew Feis shows that its apparent support for the Viet Minh played a significant symbolic role in helping them fill the power vacuum left in the wake of Japan s surrender Her study also hints that had America continued to champion the anti colonials and their quest for independence rather than caving in to the French we might have been spared our long and very lethal war in Vietnam Based partly on interviews with surviving OSS agents who served in Vietnam Bartholomew Feis s engaging narrative and compelling insights speak to the yearnings of an oppressed people and remind us that history does indeed make strange bedfellows
