



FOUNDATIONS AND FOOTINGS

SHALLOW FOUNDATIONS

Shallow foundations must be built on undisturbed soil, compacted fill material or controlled low-strength material (CLSM). (IBC 1806.2)

Depth of footings (below undisturbed ground surface) = 12" min.

Width of footings = 12" min. (IBC 1806.4)

Footings on granular soil must be located so that the line drawn between the lower edges of adjoining footings does not have a slope steeper than 30° with the horizontal, unless the material supporting the higher footing is braced or retained or otherwise laterally supported in an approved manner or a greater slope has been properly established by engineering analysis. (IBC 1806.4)

DEEP FOUNDATIONS

Geotechnical Investigation (IBC 1806.1)
Deep foundations must be designed and installed on the basis of a geotechnical investigation.
Use of Existing Deep Foundation Elements
Deep foundation elements left in place where a structure has been demolished must not be used for the support of new construction. (IBC 1806.2)

PLAIN CONCRETE FOOTINGS (IBC 1806.5)

Edge thickness of plain concrete footings supporting walls = 8" min. where placed on soil or rock. Example: Walls of light-frame construction

TERM ALERT!

• **Footings:** a foundational support, a masonry section, usually concrete, in a rectangular form wider than the bottom of the foundation wall or pier it supports.
A footing can be level, stepped level or can follow the contour of the ground.

Load-bearing values used in design for supporting soils near the surface must not exceed the values specified in this table unless data to substantiate the use of higher values are submitted and approved.

STEPPED FOOTINGS (IBC 1806.3)

Top Surface of Footings = level
Bottom Surface of Footings = max. of 1:10 slope (1 unit vertical in 10 units horizontally) 10% slope

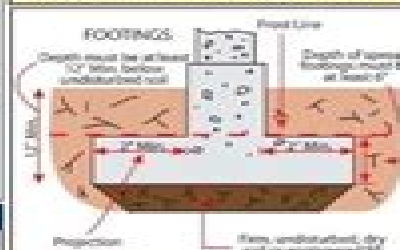
Footings must be stepped where:

- it is necessary to change the elevation of the top surface of the footing
- the surface of the ground slopes more than 1:10 slope (1 unit vertical in 10 units horizontal) 10% slope

TERM ALERT!

• **Rebar:** reinforcing bar, steel rods for reinforcing concrete.
• **Reinforcing:** steel rods or metal fabric placed in concrete slabs, beams or columns to increase their strength.
• **Shotcrete:** concrete pneumatically projected at high velocity onto a surface, usually steel reinforcement in light-frame construction, by a spray gun.

• **Concrete:** A combination of mixing cement, sand, water and aggregates.
• **Admixture:** any ingredient added to the concrete mix aside from the 4 main ones. Ex. accelerators and retarder.

PORTLAND CEMENT

• The basic ingredient of concrete
• Portland cement Types I through V vary:
Chemically: the cements differ in their content of C3A.
Physically: the cements differ in their fineness.
Performance: the cements differ in their ability to resist sulfate attacks

PORTLAND CEMENT

TYPE	CHARACTERISTICS
I	• the standard, "general purpose" cement
II	• for applications in large piers, heavy abutments and heavy retaining walls when the concrete is placed during warm weather • designed to be resistant to sulfate attacks • low C3A content
III	• used where high strengths are desired at a very early period of curing Ex. cold climate areas; the rate of hydration is significantly reduced in cold weather
IV	• Recommended where the amount and rate of heat generated must be kept to a minimum. Example: large gravity dams.
V	• used for structures exposed to soils or waters that have a high alkali content. • designed to be resistant to sulfate attacks • low C3A content

INFO. YOU MUST KNOW!

• Concrete is strong in compression but weak in tensile and shear strength.
• Concrete must be reinforced whenever tension is present.
• Concrete in footings must have a specified compressive strength (fc). Min. = 2500 lbs. per square inch.

SHOTCRETE REINFORCEMENT (IBC 1806.4)

Reinforcement used in shotcrete construction must comply with the following:
Size = No. 5 bars max.
Size Exception = Larger bars can be used if preconstruction tests demonstrate that adequate encasement can be achieved.
Clearance for No. 5 Bars (or smaller) = 2-1/2" min. between parallel reinforcement
Clearance for Bars Greater than No. 5 = 6 diameters (min.) of the bars being used

- Concrete subjected to freezing and thawing during construction must be of air-entrained concrete in accordance with Section 1904.2.
- Concrete must be air-entrained in accordance with ACI 208.
- Structure plain concrete basement walls are exempt from the requirements for exposure conditions.
- For garage floor slabs where a steel trowel finish is used, the total air content required by ACI 208 is permitted to be reduced to no less than 3% provided the compressive strength is increased to 4,000 psi.
